CHANGE IN SCHEDULE: For the final round all clubs will meet March 17 in Oakdale.

While San Jose seems determined to take team honors once again, Francis Crofut of the same city leads individual scorers with a record of 5-0. Still in contention are P. Smith of Fresno with  $4\frac{1}{2}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$ , and W.T. Adams, E.H. Mueller, L.H. Daugherty of San Jose, F. Olvera of Pittsburg, J. Scheuerman of Sacramento, R. Phetteplace and R. Baker of Fresno, all with 4-1.

Members of the various clubs are encouraged to consider the question of affiliation with the United States Chess Federation, before the matter is discussed at the meeting in Oakdale March 17. The cost to the CCCL of \$10 would include having the League's championship tournament rated by the USCF. League match games could be rated at a cost 5¢ per player.

CLUB NEWS Several clubs are now holding their annual tournaments. In Sacramento, after six rounds, the leaders are: Scheuerman  $5\frac{1}{2}$ , Edmondson, Austin, and Saca 5. In Stockton, where play is a bit irregular, Leigh leads with 10-0, followed by Minchaca 3-0 and David-Malig 5-1. No word yet on the Fresno and Pittsburg tournaments.
