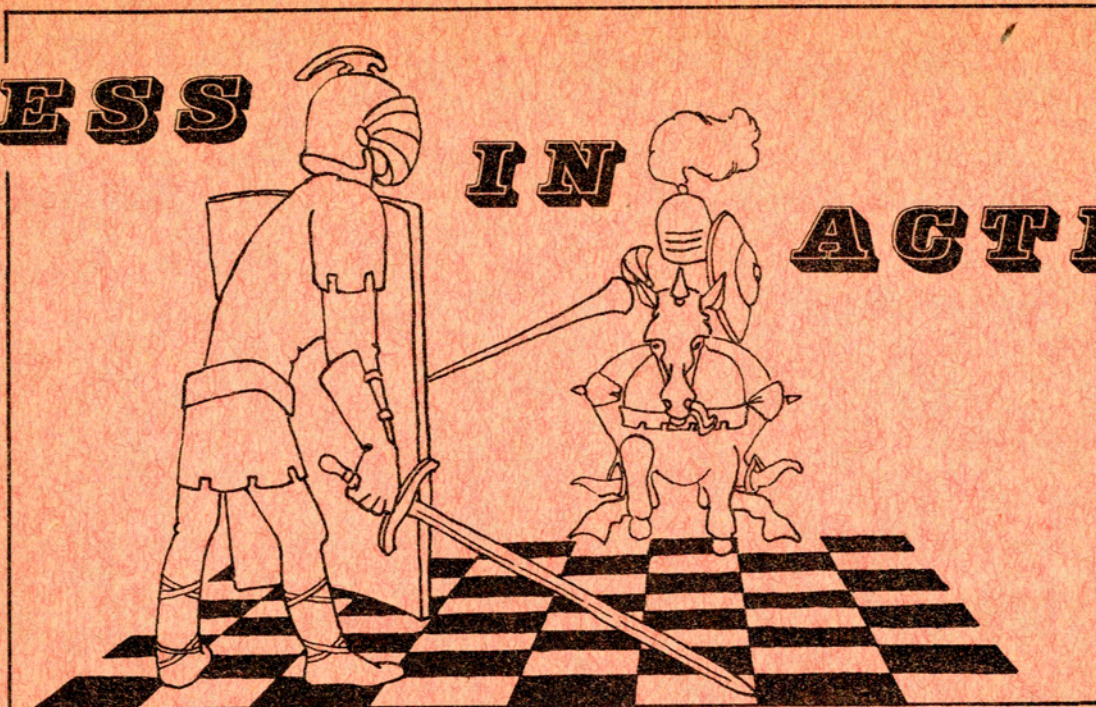

Place and Dates: Oakland Central Y.M.C.A., 2101 Telegraph Avenue; weekend of **March** 17 and 18, Saturday and Sunday. First round starts at 12 o'clock noon on Saturday, ~~March~~ 17th.

Registration will start from 10:00 A.M.

PRIZES: Trophies will be awarded to the first place in each division. Books and other prizes to second and third in each division, as well as a number of "surprise" prizes.

WHO CAN PLAY: Open to chess players who are or become members of Chess Friends of Northern California.

TYPE OF TOURNEY: At least five (5) round Swiss with three divisions: Expert-A, B and C. Tournament Director: George Koltanowski, International Chess Master.
