LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA

Hyman Gordon won the 1959 Steiner Club Masters' Tournament in a strong field of 16 entries. It was a ten round swiss. (Cross-tables page 3.)

WALLACE, IDAHO

Bruce A. Fredstrom has organized an Inland Empire Junior Chess League. Four high school teams are represented. Wallace High, Bruce's own team, currently leads 4-0.

SAN LUIS OBISPO, CALIFORNIA

W. Guthrie McClain, editor of The CALIFORNIA CHESS REPORTER, directed a 5-round swiss for the 1959 individual Calif. Collegiate Chess Championship. Imre Barlai, mathematics student from San Diego (formerly a Hungarian refugee in 1957) won 5-0.

PORTLAND, OREGON

Thanks to the unselfish efforts of Deane B. Moore, a complete Junior Chess League has been organized with 5-man teams from six high schools. Roosevelt High was leading at the end of the first half.

PLEASANT HILL, CALIFORNIA

Lt. John A. Hudson (USCF Rating 2161) won the "A" Division of the Contra Costa Country Championship. Robert A. Karch second on tie-break. Trophy for highest county resident to Ronald S. Thacker. (Cross-tables page 5)

LeRoy Turner, Stan Kilkher and Kitabayashi all tied 4-1 in "B" Division. Tie-break scores unknown. C. Seim, U.S. Navy, cinched "C" Division 5-0.

LANCASTER, CALIFORNIA

The California Junior Chess Championship will be held here June 26-27-28. Open to all who will not have reached their 21st birthday by July 15. First round begins: 1 p.m. on June 26th.

There will be no entrance fee and a number of prizes for the high scorers to share will be announced later.

The sponsoring organizations, The Los Angeles County Department of Parks and Recreation and Chess for Youth Inc. of Palmdale, will provide room and board to a select group of 25 Juniors. Youngsters with high national chess ratings or those strongly recommended by an organized chess club of the state will be invited to this group.

The winner will be proclaimed California Junior Champion by the State Federation and will receive a handsome trophy plus \$150.00 expense money so that he can represent California in the National event to be played at Omaha in July. The tournament will be named in honor of the late William B. Patterson, Antelope Valley banker and Civic Leader.

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STATE POSTAL CHAMPIONSHIP - On 11 Apr-
il, organizer Jack A. Hamilton mailed
out a progress report to all 65 partic-
ipants (some are playing in more than
one section) in the first annual (1959)
CALIFORNIA STATE CHESS FEDERATION POS-
TAL CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT. Only one
man has qualified for the Finals; out
of Section 9 with a score of 6-0.

He is Dr. Frank C. Ruys of Woodside,
Calif. Dr. Ruys is also President of
the CORRESPONDENCE CHESS LEAGUE OF A-
MERICA, the really "big" postal chess
club in this country (nearly 2,000
members!). Frank has a very high CCLA
rating, too -- Class AA 1021.

Al E. Raymond leads in section 1
with 5 wins, no losses, 1 game in pro-
gress. In section 2, Walter D. Barlow
leads 5-1 but may be overtaken by Dr.
Glenn Wood who handed Barlow his only
loss and who has 3 wins, 0 losses and
3 games in progress. Section 3 has
only 2 games completed. Raymond Walm-
isley has 3 wins and 3 uncompleted
games for a temporary lead in section
4.

The score is 4 wins, 0 losses, and 2
incomplete for Paul Klaus who is tops
in section 5. LeRoy Johnson has 3½-½
with 2 games outstanding and is captain
of section 6. For Dr. Benjamin L.
Gross it is 2½-½ and 3 incomplete in
section 7.

George R. McMahon looks like a sure
winner in section 8. He has 5 wins, 0
losses, 3 unreported.

Golden Gate & Precita Valley Jan. 20, '59.

In the Scilian, unless White is able to stage a speedy King-side attack, the 3. P-Q4 variation is not good strategy as it allows Black attacking possibilities along the open Queen Bishop file. What, then, is one to think of conceding the open Queen Knight file where White's Queen Knight Pawn is a still more inviting target? That White secures a winning advantage in this game is due to Black's failure to make the most of his opportunities.

OFF THE CHESS

Just decided to change my name--George W. Flynn to Anonymous. Think of all the books, nursery rhymes, folk songs, inventions, yes, even crimes chargeable to that name. Or perhaps as a chessist, I should change my name to N. N., the initials of the faceless opponent ("No Name") who so often plays sacrificial victim to the combinative slaughter of a grandmaster.

Speaking of name changes, I have promoted both my bishops to Archbishops. They haven't been doing too well lately and my prelates need encouragement.

Here's an idea! How about 3-minute chess--played with an egg-timer filled with sand--you know, the hour-glass principle, but the sand lasts only 3 minutes. After each move, the player turns the egg-timer over and the sands of time are running out on his opponent. If either player fails to move before the sand runs out, he loses the game.

It is easy to see that this device would promote a fast game since there would be a natural tendency to move quickly and save your sand--putting your opponent up against the same problem. However, the possibility of taking more time in a difficult situation would, it seems to me, make this game more flexible than ten-second chess.

Of course, if some mechanical wizard could figure out a bell to signal the end of the sand--so much the better!

Well, the great research is over. Remember the French champion assigned to San Francisco as vice-consul, the one whose name reminded me of mayonnaise? And Labourdannis? My facts were correct but the name turned out to be Saint-Amant. For your patience in waiting I have dug out a brief game, apparently the only one he played while on a holiday in England during the summer of 1848.

Before you go into the game, please note that it ended by the announcement of a mate in four. I hate to disagree (really I love it!) but by giving up Knight, Rook and then Queen I think White can make it last FIVE not FOUR moves. I think announcing mate a grand old custom, but just wonder if there is any penalty involved in making a false announcement. Anyway, the game....

A DEPENDABLE RATING SERVICE!

Since April 1957, when these ratings (then known as the Northwest Chess Ratings) first appeared in the WASHINGTON CHESS LETTER, it has gone like clockwork every three months.

This is in sharp contrast to another well known rating list which, although promised on a quarterly basis, has actually been published only once a year in 1957, 1958, and 1959.

PERFORMANCE, NOT REPUTATION

Players occasionally need to be reminded that knowledge of the game may far exceed performance in tournaments or league matches.

The Ratings Statistician himself may have personal knowledge of a player's ability -- but this is not a factor. All that can be measured statistically is actual performance in organized competition.

Therefore, these ratings are not "strength ratings" nor "reputation ratings", but they are performance ratings!
