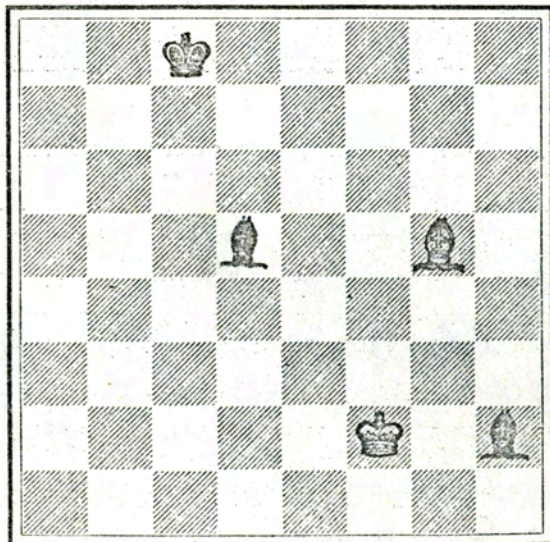

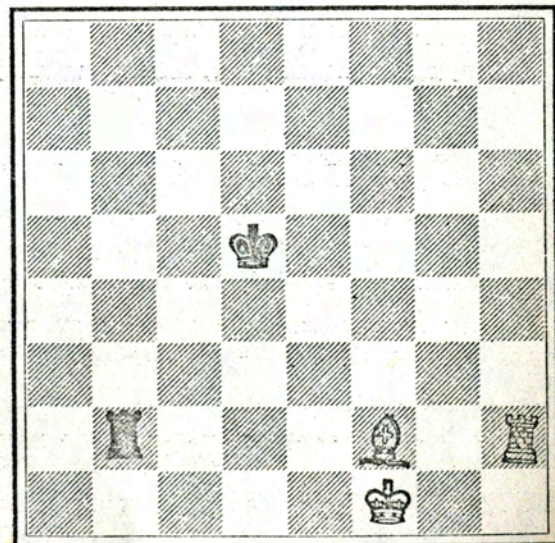
Olmsted- Kuhn
