Following are some basic rules for Davis Tournaments -

Save and follow them, please:

1. TIME LIMIT: 40 moves in two hours, 20 moves in one hour thereafter. Play starts at 7 pm.
2. LOSS by FORFEIT: A game is lost for a player who is late for more than one hour or does not come at all without excuse. A player who forfeit a game is not eligible for a prize.
3. RE-SCHEDULE: A player who is not able to play on schedule has to notify his opponent and/or tournament director before the round starts and his game will be re^scheduled.
4. REPORTING of RESULTS: Both players have to notify the tournament director about the result of their game immediately.
DO NOT WRITE RESULTS IN THE SCORE TABLES
INDICATE RESULTS IN THE PAIRING LIST.
5. GENERAL RULES: In accordance with FIDE and USCF rules.
