The Oakland Chess Club will hold its Fifth Annual Summer Tournament on Saturday and Sunday, 24 and 25 August in the Rose Room, Third Floor, Oakland Central YMCA, 2101 Telegraph Avenue, Oakland. The tournament is open to all chess players who are or will become members of the Chess Friends of Northern California (CFNC). The entry fee will be \$4 for members of CFNC; \$7 for nonmembers (includes one year's membership). The tournament will be a five-round Swiss in three classes: Expert/A, B, and C. Two trophies and two books per class are guaranteed as prizes, including our traditional Return and Progress Trophy. Three rounds will be played on Saturday; two, on Sunday.
