

IT IS WITH A DEEP SENSE OF SHOCK THAT THE CHESS WORLD LEARN-ED OF THE DEATH OF HERMAN STEINER ON NOV.25TH,1955. TO ALL OF US WHO ENJOYED HIS VIVACIOUS AND SPARKLING PERSONALITY THE SUDDENNESS OF HIS PASSING SEEMS INCREDIBLE. HIS ENERGY WAS AS BOUNDLESS AS WERE HIS TIRELESS EFFORTS IN BEHALF OF CHESS.

IT WAS HERMAN STEINER WHO ACCELERATED CHESS ACTIVITY IN THE WEST TO IT'S PRESENT IMPRESSIVE HEIGHTS. IT WAS HE WHO WAS THE DRIVING FORCE BEHIND ALMOST ALL OF THE MAJOR TOURNAMENTS IN CALIFORNIA, INCLUDING SUCH OUTSTANDING EVENTS AS THE 1ST AND 2ND PAN-AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL TOURNAMENTS.

HERMAN STEINER EDITED ONE OF THE MOST EXTENSIVE AND INFORMATIVE NEWSPAPER CHESS COLUMNS IN THE UNITED STATES. CHESS PL AYERS THROUGHOUT CALIFORNIA AND OTHER WESTERN STATES READ HIS COLUMN AVIDLY EACH WEEK, FOR NOWHERE ELSE COULD THEY OBTAIN SUCH COMPREHENSIVE COVERAGE OF NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL CHESS ACTIVITY.

HERMAN STEINER'S CLUB-OUR CLUB- WAS THE FOCAL CENTER OF ACT-IVITY IN LOS ANGELES, AND IT WAS THERE HE RADIATED THE WARMTH OF PERSONALITY THAT ENVELOPED ALL. HE HAD A HOST OF FRIENDS AND ADMIRERS, AND NO WONDER-FOR HE LOVED PEOPLE. HERMAN STEINER GAVE GENEROUSLY OF HIMSELF TO EVERYONE AND EVERYTHING THAT NEEDED SUPPORT; AND THOUGH HE HAS LEFT AN EMPTY PLACE THAT NONE CAN EVER FILL, HE HAS HANDED ON FOR US TO PERPETUATE, THE AIMS, THE IDEALS, AND THE PURPOSE, WHICH MADE HIS OWN LIFE SO RICH IN ACHIEVEMENT.
