

BENKO WINS U.S. OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP

Highest Score Ever Attained At Largest Open

Hungarian born International Grandmaster Pal Benko, of New York City, topped a record field of 198 players at the U.S. Open held in San Francisco August 14th to 26th with a record-breaking score of 11-1. By drawing only two games and winning 10, Benko's score was the highest ever achieved in the sixty-three consecutive years that the event has been conducted.

The tournament conducted in the picturesque city of San Francisco was the largest attended Open—Milwaukee, 1953—with 183 players holding that first place spot for the last eight years.

Benko's play was outstanding as he held the first place spot throughout the entire event. He won games from Cuneo, Weinberg, Morgan, Lapiken, Otteson, Kovacs, Addison, Rivise, H. Gross and defending champion Robert Byrne. His two draws were registered with Louis Levy of Paterson, N. J. and Arthur Bisguier of New York, a former Open Champion.

Close at Benko's heels in clear second place, a fellow Hungarian countryman, Zoltan Kovacs, now a resident of Los Angeles, scored 10-2, which in last year's Open at St. Louis was a good enough score to win the tournament. Kovacs is the California State Champion in addition to California Open champ. His only loss was to Benko and draws with Bisguier and Irving Rivise of Los Angeles netted his 10 points.

Grandmaster Arthur Bisguier, paired with Robert Byrne in the final round, lost a closely contested battle and knocked himself out of clear second place, ending with a score of 9½-2½ which tied with Byrne at 3rd and 4th. Bisguier's draws were with Kovacs, Benko and Rivise while Byrne's were with Loftson, Gersch and Edgar McCormick, the U.S. Amateur Champion.

Two players tied for 5th and 6th at 9-3. They were William G. Addison of San Francisco who drew with Gersch, Bourke, Osbun, H. Gross and lost to Benko and Joseph G. Sullivan who drew no games but lost to Kovacs, Byrne and Lapiken.

A six way tie for 7th through twelfth was registered by the following players who earned scores of 8½-3½: Martin Harrow—Rego Park, N. Y., Irving Rivise—Los Angeles, Charles Henin—New York City, Jack Witeczek—Lorain, Ohio, James Schmitt—San Francisco and Rex Wilcox of Salinas, California. Over \$3000 in cash prizes were awarded.

Eleven women competed in the U.S. Women's Open Championship and first place was captured by Mrs. Eva Asonson of Chicago, Illinois with a score of 7-5. Mrs. Aronson is a former champion, winning the event in Milwaukee, 1953. In second place spot with a score of 6-6 was Mary Selensky of Philadelphia. Kathryn Slater of New York City, the 1958 Champion, entering the last round with 5½ points, looked as though she would be clear second but missed what appeared to be an easily won game. She shared 3rd-4th place with Mabel Burlingame of Phoenix, Arizona, but was awarded the third place trophy on tie-breaking points. Lucille Kellner of Detroit and little Cecilia Rock of Beckett, Mass., tied at 5th place with scores of 5 points each. Lisa Lane the defending champion did not participate.

San Francisco will be probably remembered as the "best" Open ever held. The beautiful city of San Francisco and the charming hospitality of the local committee consisting of Henry Gross, Guthrie McClain and Mr. and Mrs. Spencer Van Gelder, was one of the great highlights of the event. Once again, International Master George Koltanowski and his competent staff directed the event without difficulties and with complete control and pleasantness. An awards banquet was held at the end of the contest and a Sunday brunch during mid-tournament. Many informal parties were held throughout the two weeks by individuals. As reported elsewhere in CHESS LIFE, San Antonio, Texas, has been chosen as next year's U.S. Open site.



PAL BENKO was born in Amiens, France on July 15th, 1928. His family moved to Budapest when he was four years old and four years after that his father taught he and his older brother the moves. Most of his early training as a chessplayer came from books and from solving problems. When he entered high school at 12 years of age, he competed in his first tournament and continued playing in tournaments sporadically during his school years. At the age of 17 he entered his first tournament where Hungarian masters were also competing. He won the tournament and was awarded the title of Hungarian Master. Shortly after that, at 20, he won the Hungarian Championship and at 22, FIDE awarded the title of International Master to him for his performance in matches against the USSR. He was the high scorer for Hungary in the three matches that he played against Russia. In 1957 he left Hungary and competed in the European Zonal Championship at Dublin and took first place. Making his home then in the United States, he competed in the Interzonal at Portoroz and placed third, qualifying for the World's Candidates tournament and earning the International Grandmaster title. Probably the most active Grandmaster in American tournaments, he has won the Greater New York Open Championship twice, the Western Open Championship twice, the Manhattan Chess Club Championship twice and has placed either second or third in the last two U.S. Opens and the 1961 N.Y. State Championship. He is a securities dealer and life insurance underwriter by profession and lives alone in New York City. His principle interests outside of chess are reading and visits to the opera. He will become a U.S. citizen in 1962.

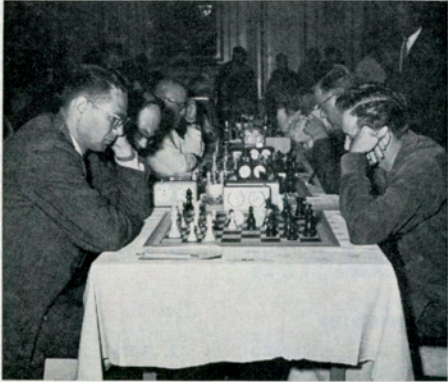
