

Steiner, Los Angeles Speed King

No one of the other twenty-one contestants in the Los Angeles County speed tourney could hold a candle to Herman Steiner so the U. S. Champion added another title to his string. He walked all

over the opposition by tallying a magnificent $20\frac{1}{2}-1\frac{1}{2}$ for a three and a half point margin over Harry Borochoff, 17-4, who took second prize. Still further behind at $15\frac{1}{2}-5\frac{1}{2}$ was William Steckel. Weinbaum and Weiss were bracketed at 14-7.
