PASADENA JUNIOR TOURNAMENT....held through June and July, won by David FORTHOFFER of Glendale High, with the fine score of 6½-½. He won a year's USCF membership. Tied for second and third were Robert FOTTS of Pasadena High and Andy VINOCK of Muir High, each receiving a junior membership in the club for one year.

MONTEREY PARK SUMMER RATING TOURNAMENT....the come-as-you-go 50¢ per round tourney, very successful every year. Leaders after 9 rounds of this year's caper, Ben KAKIMI, 5 - 1; R. KOTZ, 3½- ½, I. INTERNATIONALLY SPEAKING.....a lot has happened recently. A quick coverage -

Rubinstein Memorial at Polanica Zdruj, Poland, won by VASIUKOV of Russia and DELI of Hungary with 9½-3½. MATULOVICH third.

Asztalos Memorial at Gyula, Hungary, swamped by KORCHNOI with 14½-½. Wow! Next two, LENGYEL and HONFI of Hungary, 9 - 6!

WORLD JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP at Barcelona, Spain - winner KURAICA of Yugoslavia, 6½-2½. Ahead of TUKMAKOV, Russia and HARTOGH, Holland, 6-3. The USA was not represented.

Tchigorin Memorial at Sochi, Soviet Georgia - with four rounds to go, SPASSKY leads with 8 - 3, UNZICKER 7½-3½, ZAITSEV of Russia 6½-4½. Six grandmasters in this one.

CAPABLANCA MEMORIAL at Havana, Cuba, now halfway over. After 11 rounds, IVKOV is tops with 9 - 2, SMYSLOV 8½-2½, FISCHER of USA 8 - 3. GELLER, PACHMAN 7½-3½, DONNER, KHOLMOV 7 - 4. IVKOV, GELLER, PACHMAN, KHOLMOV and PARMA have not lost a game yet. FISCHER has lost to IVKOV and drew with CIOCALTEA, PARMA, O'KELLY and WADE.....According to Radio Havana, FISCHER fired Frank BRADY as his intermediary or referee because BRADY disturbed his concentration. His replacement, REINERDT, USCF.
