## THE BIGGEST GAME OF ALL.....

If RESHEVSKY draws, he qualifies by virtue of his better tie-breaking points at Tunisia. If HORT wins, he'll be at the 4½ mark. Of course if RESHEVSKY wins, he's an easy winner.
