Chess Armies Attack on Silent Battlefields

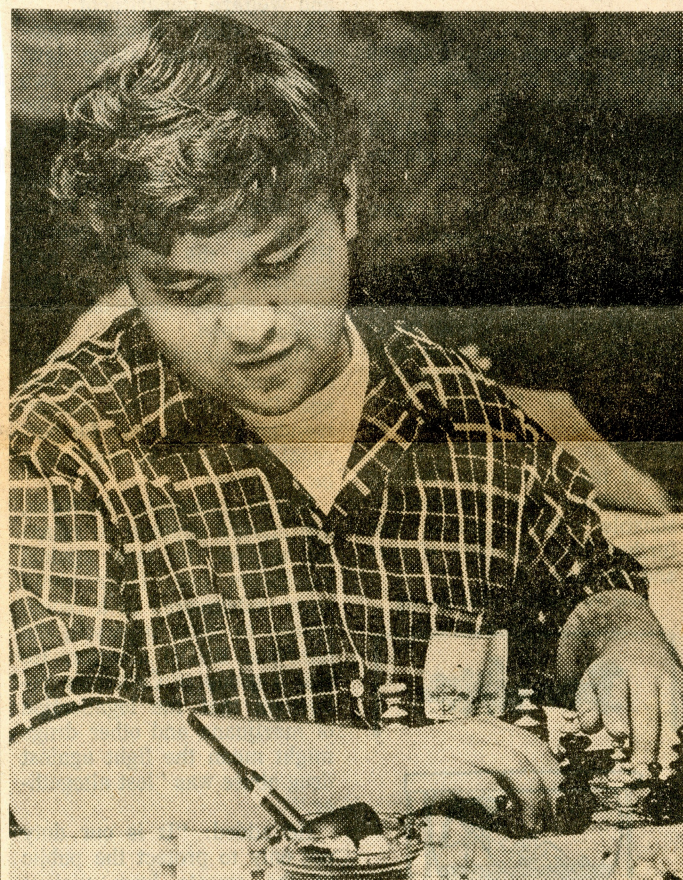

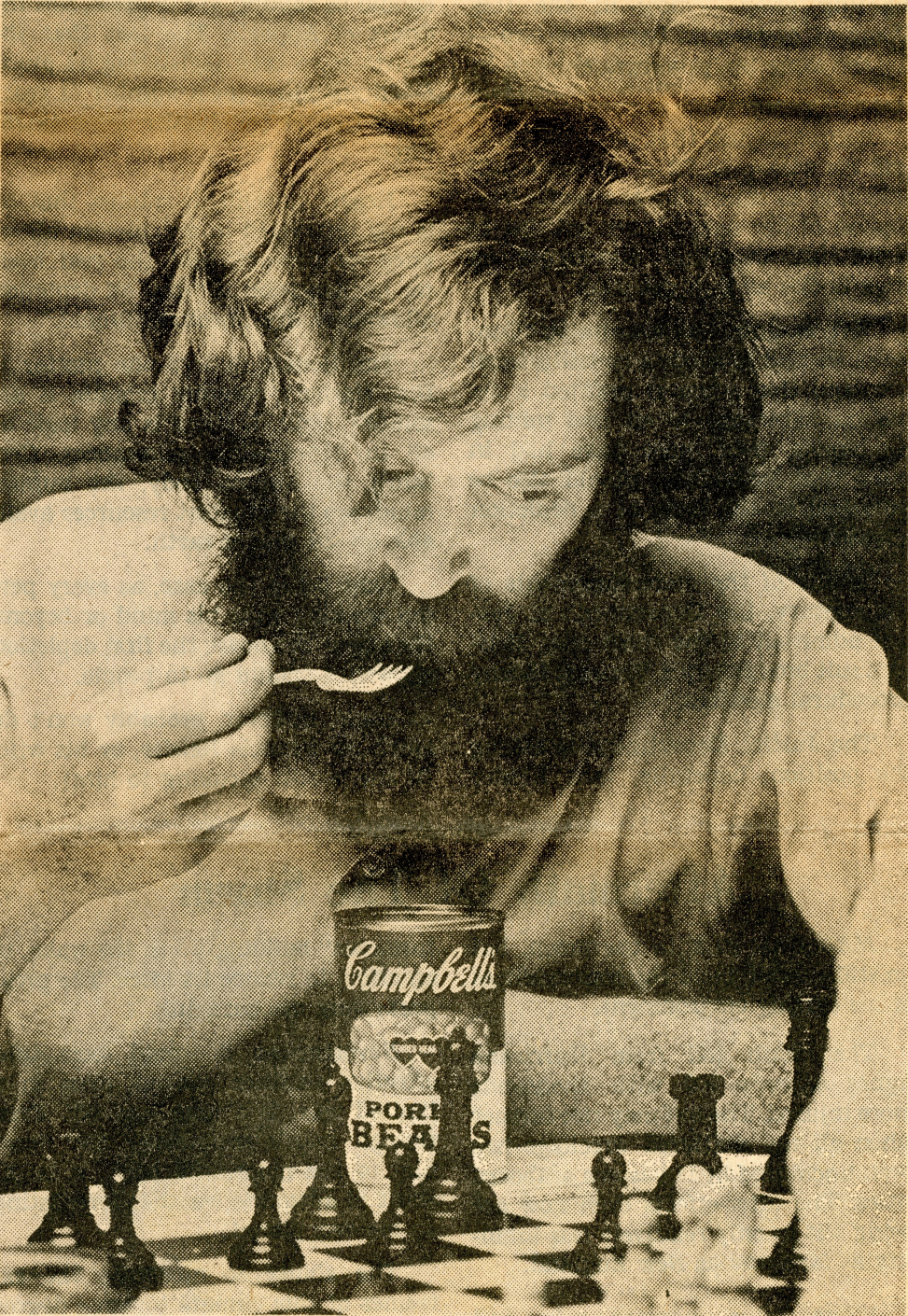
