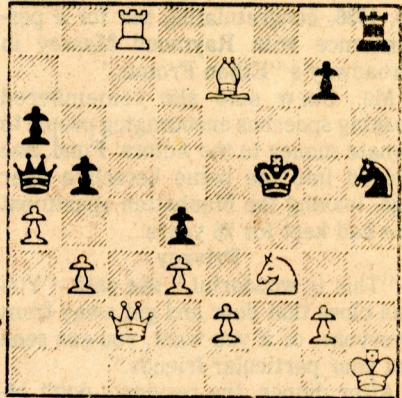

Victor Kupreichik of the Soviet Union won the recent 14-man round robin tournament held in Hastings, England. He won six, drew six and lost one in compiling a 9-4 score.

The other Russian in the field, former world champion Vassily Smyslov, and Jonathan Spelman of England tied for second with 8-5 scores.

Two Americans were entered in the tournament. Anatoly Lein finished in the middle of the pack with a 7-6 score. In one of his poorest performances in years, Larry Christiansen won one, lost five and drew seven for a 4½-9½ score.

The third annual Brighton International Tournament in England preceded the Hastings tournament and was won by Murray Chandler of New Zealand who scored 6-3 in the 10-man round robin.

Nigel Short and Spelman tied for second with 5½-3½.
