Central California Chess League

The CCCL supplied 18 players for the North's 68 board team. The average board played was 36.22, just slightly above the overall average of 34.5. These players scored $10\frac{1}{3}$ - $7\frac{1}{3}$.

Fresno players made the best showing scoring 3-0 at an average board of 21.0. Sacramento scored 2-3 at 24.8, San Jose 2-1 at 37.0, Pittsburg $2\frac{1}{2}$ - $1\frac{1}{2}$ at 41.75, Modesto 0-2 at 59.5, and Stockton 1-0 at 68.0.
