Vasily Smyslov, the 35-year-old challenger for the chess championship of the world, beat Mikhael Botvinnik, the champion since 1948, in the first game of the 24-game match in Moscow. Botvinnik had the white pieces and started with 1.P-K4. It was a Sicilian defense, and White resigned after the 41st move.

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
