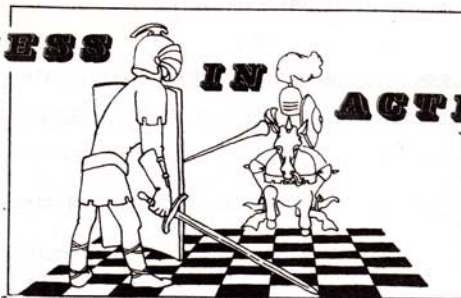
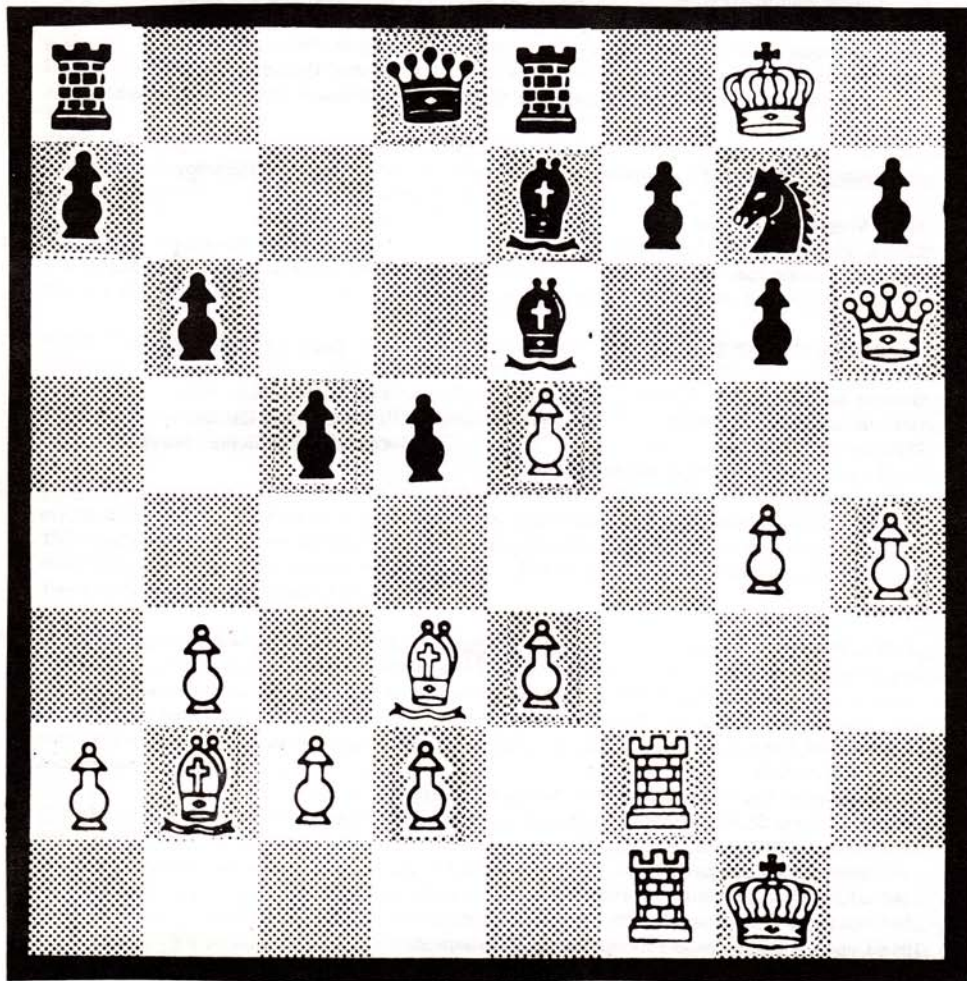

STATEMENT OF POLICY

WHO OWNS CFNC

CFNC is owned by its membership and derives all its funds from its membership. Like other large organizations, the membership utilizes a board of directors to carry out its wishes. This is your organization, and here are some facts about your organization that are repeated here for those members who may have forgotten them, and for those new members who may not be familiar with them.

FACTS ABOUT CFNC

1. Our Tradition: CFNC was founded 17 years ago and was dedicated then even as now to the promotion of chess among the "B" (intermediate), the "C" (average), and the beginner player. A key part of this program consists of providing separate tournaments all run simultaneously to permit "C" players to play only with other "C" players, "B" players to play only with other "B" players, and "A" players to play only with other "A" players. In this way, any player regardless of his strength has the opportunity to play with other players of his own approximate strength in competing for the first-place trophy and other prizes in his division.
2. USCF Affiliation: CFNC was the first chess organization in the State of California to affiliate with the United States Chess Federation. Our chess organization affiliated even before the California State Chess Federation affiliated.
3. USCF Support: In their time of need two years ago, we contributed \$100.00 cash to the USCF. We have conducted many USCF membership drives. In addition, we have encouraged many young players to develop their chess talent, and these players have later become USCF members.
4. USCF Tournaments: Along with our CFNC tournaments, we also hold USCF tournaments; for example, we have held three USCF tournaments in the last three months (one of these qualified Jim Ulrich to play in the 1968 California State Chess Championship Tournament to be held in San Francisco next fall), and we will be holding other USCF tournaments later this month (see back cover) and this June 22/23, 1968.
5. Junior Tournaments: Last year we inaugurated Junior Regional Chess Championship Tournaments culminating in a playoff for the Northern California Junior Championship by age groups. This feature encourages even the very young players to compete for recognition and prizes with other players of his own approximate strength. For further details, refer to the 1967/1968 Junior Championship report in this issue.
6. League Play: We have just completed our most successful league season. A total of 25 teams competed in three areas, and competition has never been so sharp. Along with the playoff for the first-place teams, for the first time we are holding a playoff for the runner-up teams. Also for the first time, we are sending out complete cross-tables to all contestants showing the round-by-round scores and rating changes for each player of each team throughout the season and in the playoffs.
7. Instantaneous Ratings: Two years ago we inaugurated the instantaneous rating system (IRS), thus making our rating system the most up-to-date system in the U.S. (probably in the world). This system permits each player to know his initial rating before each game he plays, to know his handicap rating at the start of each game (+4% of the difference in ratings), and to know his final rating at the end of each game (+16 points for a win, -16 points for a loss, and no change for a draw). We utilize the USCF rating system, but we have made it instantaneous so that instead of waiting months for the rating results, each player knows his rating the instant he completes his game. The procedure for calculating rating changes has been simplified to the point where anyone can easily determine his own rating.
8. Chess in Action: Our magazine is published quarterly and each issue includes all notices of upcoming tournaments, the detailed results of each completed tournament including a cross-table showing the round-by-round scores and rating changes of each player (thereby permitting

each player to check his round-by-round rating changes), and a complete and up-to-date list of all members and their current ratings. In addition to these basic features, our magazine contains features of general interest.

9. Club Support: Our CFNC organization supports clubs in many ways. For example, if a club wishes to hold a club tournament, we provide score sheets, wall charts, and pairing cards absolutely free. If a club wishes to hold an Open CFNC-Rated Tournament, we provide 1,000 score sheets, wall charts, and 120 pairing cards all absolutely free. This is in accordance with a basic CFNC policy that we do not charge clubs for any service. We are a membership-oriented organization, and receive no money from any chess club.

10. Administrative Procedures: The primary purpose of our organization is to promote chess in Northern California. We accomplish this purpose by holding chess tournaments, conducting league play, maintaining up-to-date ratings, publishing our "Chess In Action" magazine, supporting chess clubs, and performing administrative tasks. Our organization is membership-oriented (as contrasted to club-oriented) and our membership is the final authority on all matters. Our board of directors implements our memberships' wishes by carrying out the purposes of our organization. In turn, our board of directors delegates the responsibility for specific tasks to individual directors (the magazine editor is responsible for "Chess In Action", the rating administrator for ratings, etc.) and along with the responsibility, each director is given the authority to carry out his responsibility as he sees fit (the treasurer pays bills without asking the permission of the board of directors). Thus, in the democratic tradition, an individual is given the responsibility and authority to carry out a task, a board of directors exercises control over these individuals, and the membership exercises control over the board of directors. Also in the true democratic tradition, each of our members can cast one vote on all critical issues. We use the petition as a means for permitting 100% of our membership to vote as contrasted to "open meetings" wherein usually less than 10% of the membership participate. Refer to our CFNC Constitution (in this issue) for further details.

To assist the individual members of the board of directors in carrying out their duties, board of directors meetings are held at least four times a year (about one month prior to the publication of our magazine). These meetings have a standard agenda that parallels the purposes of our organization, i. e., (1) tournaments, (2) league play, (3) ratings, (4) the magazine, (5) club support, and (6) administration. All board meetings are open to any CFNC member who wishes to attend, but are not open to non-CFNC members whether they be visiting firemen, reporters, or friends, unless the majority of the board grant this special privilege. As a CFNC member, if you wish to exercise this privilege, contact any member of the board for time and place of the next meeting (for example, two CFNC members have attended recent board meetings; Mr. Morrison attended the Sunnyvale meeting and Jonathan Hale attended the Berkeley meeting).

SUMMARY

We are proud of our organization! After 17 years, our membership is at an all-time high, we are financially solvent, and we are continually improving the services we provide to chess players in the Northern California region.

CONSTITUTION OF THE CHESS FRIENDS OF NORTHERN CALIFORNIA

Article I — NAME: The name of this organization shall be the "Chess Friends of Northern California," otherwise known as the CFNC.

Article II — PURPOSE: The purposes of this organization are: (a) to enable its members to play the game of CHESS, (b) to conduct and/or sponsor tournaments, matches, league play, and other forms of chess competition, (c) to establish and maintain a rating system for rating chessplayers in the organization, and (d) to promote the popularity of the game of chess.

Article III — MEMBERSHIP: (a) Any person may become a member of the organization upon payment of the annual dues, (b) in the event that any member of the organization should be guilty of conduct which in the judgement of three-fourths of the members of the board of directors shall tend to bring the game of chess into disrepute, his membership may be revoked.

Article IV — ORGANIZATION: (a) The officers of the club shall be a Chairman, Secretary-Treasurer, Tournament Director, Publicity Director, Rating Administrator, Magazine Editor, and Regional Directors as required, (b) they shall be members of CFNC, (c) they shall constitute in their entirety the Board of Directors of CFNC, (d) by a majority vote, they shall have the right to fill vacancies on the Board of Directors, (e) by a majority vote, they shall have the right to expell any member from the Board of Directors, and (f) they shall maintain friendly relations with other chess organizations.

Article V — DUTIES OF OFFICERS: (a) The Chairman shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors and shall appoint all committees; (b) the Secretary-Treasurer shall keep the minutes of all meetings, carry on the correspondence of the club, collect all authorized dues, deposit all funds in an approved bank, make all necessary disbursements of funds, prepare a financial statement for the first Board of Directors' meeting each calendar year, and submit a list of the active members of CFNC with their expiration dates to the Magazine Editor prior to the publication of each magazine issue; (c) the Tournament Director shall arrange and supervise league play in CFNC, act as tournament director for CFNC and CFNC-sponsored tournaments when mutually agreeable, and submit league results and tournament results (when acting as tournament director) to Rating Administrator so they can be rated; (d) the Publicity Director shall arrange for the publication of CFNC events and results through all media as he sees fit; (e) the Rating Administrator shall maintain the ratings of all CFNC members and submit a list of the members' ratings to the Magazine Editor prior to the publication of each magazine issue; (f) the Magazine Editor shall publish the official CFNC magazine "Chess In Action" at regular intervals as he sees fit; and (g) the Regional Directors shall promote CFNC and the game of chess in their regions. Each officer is free to act as he sees fit.

Article VI — DUTIES OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS: In addition to the duties already mentioned, the Board of Directors shall (a) formulate a program of activities to promote chess, (b) provide guidance to the Officers, and (c) shall cooperate with each other in the fullest sense to promote the CFNC.

Article VII — DUES: The CFNC membership annual dues shall be \$3.00 per year.

Article VIII — MEETINGS: The Board of Directors may meet at any time and place upon call of any officer, upon concurrence of the majority of the Board.

Article IX — AMENDMENTS OF THE CONSTITUTION: This constitution may be changed or amended by a two-thirds majority vote of the members of the Board of Directors.

Article X — MEMBERSHIP PEROGATIVES: The membership shall have the perogative to make the final decision in any and all matters by petition subject to the following conditions: (a) that the petition contain a statement signed by the executive board presenting their position on the matter and (b) that the petition then be signed by two-thirds of the paid-up members.

The 1968 New Year Open was held at the Walnut Creek Recreation Center on the weekend of January 6/7, 1968. A total of 98 players participated in this Concord/Walnut Creek Chess Clubs event. CFNC Tournament Director Jerry Long acted as tournament director.

Congratulations are extended to John Smail for winning first place, to V. Fong for winning second place, to M. Weber and R. Cuneo for winning third and fourth places (tie-breaks), and to M. Watson for winning fifth place (tie-breaks) in the "A" division. Congratulations are also extended to J. Fosaaen for winning first place, and to G. Roy, R. Bentson, D. Clapp, and E. Phillips (our editor!) for winning second thru fifth places (tie-breaks) in the "B" division. Congratulations are also extended to newcomers S. Martinez and B. Rose for winning first and second place (tie-breaks), to T. Hibbard for winning third place, and to K. Stocksdale and T. Anderson for winning fourth and fifth places (tie-breaks) in the "C" division.

Six contestants played in the Open USCF division with the following results: first - John Blackstone; second - Frank Thornally; third - Kon Grivainis; fourth - D. Fritzinger; fifth - Jim Iwashita; and sixth - P. Smith.

Nineteen contestants played in the Junior division. Congratulations are extended to T. Lojo (first place), to J. Eliason, E. Lee, and J. Shearer (tied for second place), and to M. Vasquez (fifth place). Round-by-round scores and rating changes are presented in the following cross-tables:
