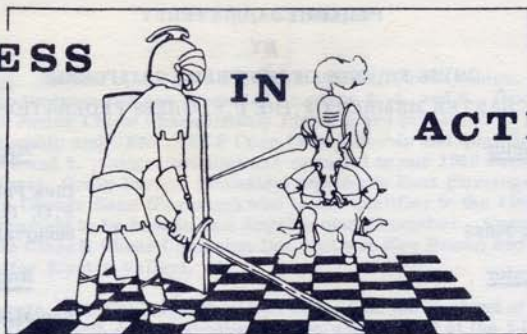
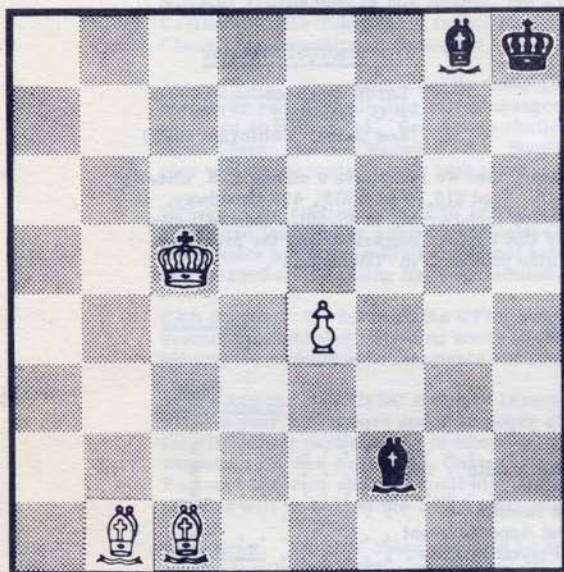
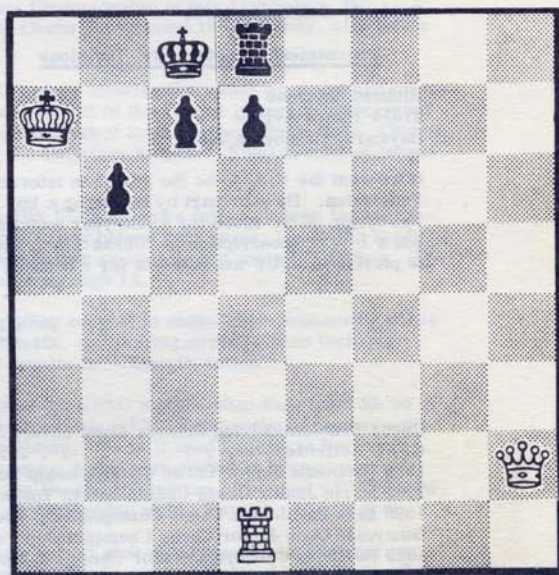

In response to the interest expressed in the four problems presented in our last issue for B- and C-players (we had 51 perfect solutions), four similar problems are presented in this issue. Prizes will be awarded for the best set of solutions submitted by a B-player and by a C-player. From one to ten points will be awarded for each problem, depending on the correctness and completeness of the solution; 40 points represents a perfect score. Send solutions to the editor not later than 1 May 1969. As a review, Problem No. 5 is a one-mover and you should consider what must have occurred just prior the position shown. If you like to mate with your queen, you will like Problems No. 6 and 7; both are two-movers with minimum pieces, one with a theme similar to Problem No. 3. For the endgame enthusiast (and so we won't get 51 perfect solutions), we present Problem No. 8; this classic problem requires two main variations depending on whether Black advances the center and a side pawn or advances the two side pawns to the fifth rank.

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CFNC ACTIVITIES

Tournament Results. Results of the 1969 Peninsula Junior, Marin Junior, and East Bay Junior Chess Championship tournaments are presented on pages 4, 5, and 6. Results of the 1969 Northern California Junior Chess Championship Playoffs are presented on page 7. Results of the 1969 CFNC Championship and CFNC/USCF Open Championship and Qualifier Tournaments are presented on pages 8 and 9. Congratulations are extended to our 1969 Junior Chess Champions Harry Radke (San Jose), Craig Barnes (Berkeley) and Shawn Hurt (Saratoga). Congratulations are also extended to George Kane (Berkeley) who is our qualifier to the 1969 California State Chess Championship Tournament to be held in Los Angeles next December. Congratulations are also extended to our 1969 Class B Chess Champion Dan McLeod (San Bruno) and to our 1969 Class C Champion Steve Leifur (Castro Valley).

Upcoming Tournaments. The Carlmont Open will be held on the weekend of March 22-23 at the Carlmont YMCA. The Fourth Annual Peninsula Open will be held at the LERA main auditorium in Sunnyvale on the weekend of April 26-27 (note the change in date, due to auditorium not being available on the weekend of April 19-20); see page 9 for further details. The Sunnyvale Open Junior Chess Championship Tournament will also be held at LERA on the weekend of April 26-27; see page 6 for further details. For those of you who like a three-round one-day tournament, the 1969 Four-leaf Clover Chess Tournament is for you; see page 18 for further details. Later in the year, the following events are scheduled: the Hayward Chess Festival in July; the Oakland Summer Tournament in late August, the LERA Class Championship in late September, the Carlmont Chess Tournament in October, the Novato Chess Tournament in November, and Junior Chess Championships in December.

League Play. Crosstables for the 1968-1969 CFNC League showing the round-by-round and player-by-player results (including rating changes) for the first half of the League season are presented on pages 10 through 14. New teams challenging the established teams include Santa Rosa, Chabot, Santa Clara, Novato, Redwood City, Stanford, and the Daly City Knights. Final results of league play will be presented in our next issue.

Ratings. We continue the CFNC policy of using the IRS (instantaneous rating system) for tournaments and league play whereby each player knows his rating before each game, knows his handicap rating once his opponent is known, and knows his new rating as soon as his game is finished. The March 1969 CFNC rating list is presented on pages 15 through 18.

Club Support. We continue the CFNC policy of providing support to chess clubs sponsoring chess events; this includes providing score sheets, wall charts, and pairing cards; it also includes placing tournament announcements and tournament results in "Chess In Action".

Board Action. The CFNC Board of Directors reduced the CFNC membership dues from \$3.00 to \$2.00 a year for Juniors under 16 years of age. It also made CFNC membership a requirement for all Juniors participating in future Junior Tournaments. We still need additional Regional Directors for San Francisco, Oakland, and other areas. Anyone interested in becoming a Regional Director should submit his application to the Board of Directors. The next CFNC Board meeting will be held at the LERA main auditorium on Wednesday night, May 8th, at 8:00 p.m.

Club News. The IBM chess club will be holding their annual club championship tournament next month; it will be a CFNC-rated event. The LERA chess club has just completed their spring C-tournament and will start a B-tournament next month. The San Bruno chess club is to be commended for publishing a truly outstanding monthly news letter. The Daly City chess club is planning for their second annual summer chess picnic, and the LERA club will be looking for revenge for the defeat they suffered at the hands of the Daly City club last summer. The Oakland chess club will also be looking for revenge when they meet the LERA club this summer in a repeat of last summer's 22-player event which they lost by the close score of 10.5 to 11.5.

SECOND ANNUAL 1969 PENINSULA JUNIOR CHESS CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT

The Second Annual 1969 Peninsula Junior Chess Championship Tournament was held at the LERA main auditorium, Sunnyvale, on the weekend of January 25-26, 1969. A total of 58 Juniors between the ages of 5 and 15 years competed in three age groups for trophies and playoff berths in the upcoming Northern California Junior Championships (see page 7). In the 19-player 10 year and under division, congratulations are extended to Matthew Sullivan (first), to Shawn Hurt and Dominic Carlos (second and third on tie-breaks), to Ted Fong (fourth), and to Victor Yalom, Mark Thorson, Colleen Meier, and Kevin Meier (fifth, sixth, seventh, and eighth on tie-breaks). In the 22-player 11, 12, and 13 year division, congratulations are extended to Todd Lowenstein (first), to Eric Ford (second), and to Brian Gong, Todd Corenson, and Jeffrey White (third, fourth, and fifth on tie-breaks). In the 17-player 14 and 15 year division, congratulations are extended to Harry Radke and Carl Mueller (first and second on tie-breaks) and to Neil Spingarn, Bill Bentkowsky, and Mike McLeod (third, fourth, and fifth on tie-breaks). The top two players in each division received handsome trophies; the top three players in each division (or their alternates) qualified to play in the Northern California Junior Championship Tournament (see page 7); and all players received Certificates of Participation signed by International Chessmaster George Koltanowski. Five year old Kevin Meier was voted the "Outstanding Player" trophy for tying for fourth place in the 19-player 10 year and under division. Results for all divisions were as follows:

TYPE OF TOURNEY, PRIZES, AND ENTRY FEE: A series of four-player Round Robin sections (either USCF or CFNC) wherein you play one game with each other player in your section (3 games in all). You will be placed in a section with players of your own approximate strength. The winner of each section will receive a trophy. The entry fee is \$3.00.

The California State Chess Championship Tournament was held at the Mechanics Institute in San Francisco in the latter part of December 1968. Our CFNC qualifier, Mr. David Blohm, emerged victorious over a strong field and will reign as State Champion until next December. At that time our 1969 CFNC state qualifier, Mr. George Kane (along with eight other contestants) will try to wrest the title from Dave. Good luck to both of you!

World Chess Champion Tigran Petrosian and challenger Boris Spassky are still in training for their 24-game world championship match which is scheduled to start April 14, 1969. Although the odds-makers favor Spassky, Harry Golombek of England favors Petrosian. Maybe he knows something we don't; he was present at the match three years ago when Petrosian successfully defended his title against Spassky. He was also present at the match six years ago when Petrosian won the world championship from Botvinnik.

One reason that the San Bruno team is a strong contender for the West Bay League Championship is the McLeod family. Dan McLeod recently won the CFNC 1969 "B" Class Championship and Mike McLeod tied for second place in the CFNC 1969 "C" Class Championship. When San Bruno needs added support, they call on Nancy McLeod. All three McLeods play on the team!

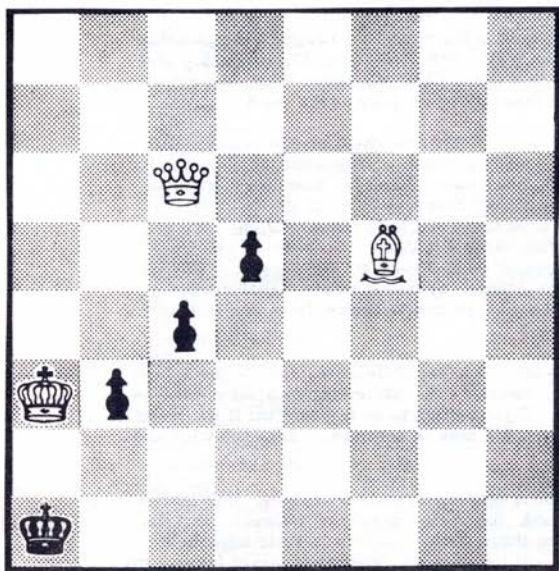
We were very pleased that so many members were intrigued by the four chess problems presented in our last issue of "Chess In Action." However, we ended up with a problem that appeared to be more difficult to solve than any of the four problems presented. Namely, how do you give out prizes for 51 perfect solutions without bankrupting the CFNC treasury? With the help of our Texas friend Ken Smith (Chess Digest), we think we have found a satisfactory solution. We will try to give each winner his choice of one of the following three booklets: "Lasker vs Pillsbury" by Brandreth (an exceptional value), "Thirty Two-Movers" compiled by P. Wenman (for the problem fancier), and "The Dragon Sicilian - Yugoslav Attack" by Keene (Latest analysis from England). The one and only shipment of this latter booklet is due to arrive from England any day now.

Problem No. 8 (back cover of this issue) is an old classic. The two white pawns and the black king are mutually stalemated (whichever one has to move, loses). The white king must break the onslaught of the three united and passed black pawns. This position is so famous that it was once called "the little game of chess." White should win, but his task is not easy. Lets see what you can do with this one.

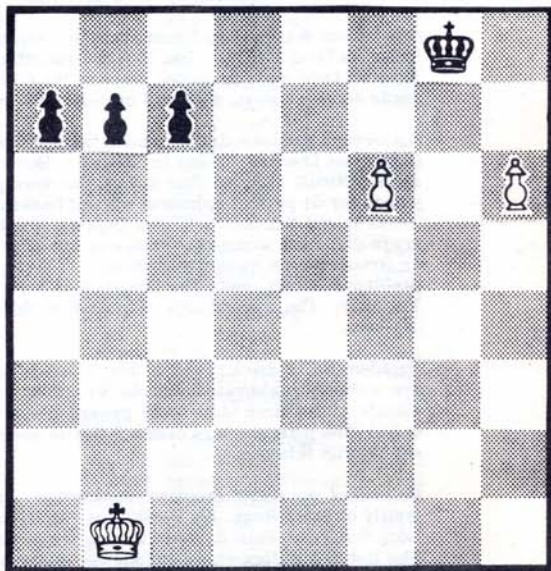

No. 8 White to play and win

Solutions to problems submitted in the last issue. Problem No. 1 - White has completed the first half of his castling move; he now completes the second half and plays R-Q1 mate. Problem No. 2 - The only move that will mate is P-N6, but this is illegal unless it is a capturing move; therefore Black must have just played P-B4 so that White can now play P X P e.p. mate. Problem No. 3 - White cannot mate once Black plays P-KR3, therefore White must blockade the pawn with 1. R-R6; after 1.... P X R then 2 P-N7 mates, and after 1.... B-any then 2 R X P mates. Problem No. 4 - You can win money betting against players who insist that the first move must be with the Knight, as otherwise it is stalemate. First, with the pawns going up the board: 1. B-B6 P X B; 2. K-B8 P-B4; 3 N-B7 mate. Then, with the pawns coming down the board: 1. K-B3 P-N8(Q); 2. N-B2ch Q X Nch; 3 K X Q mate. If 1.... P-N8(N)ch; 2. K-B7ch N-B6; 3. B X N mate. If 1.... P-N(R); 2. N-B7 mate. If 1.... P-N8(B)ch; 2. K-K7 mate.
