RESUME OF CLUB'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETINGS

An adjourned regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Oakland Chess Club was held on 19 July. Actions taken:

(1) Adoption of financial reports postponed "until the Treasurer shall present also the financial report on the 1968 CFNC Summer Chess Championship Tournament [co-sponsored by this club]" (Anderson)

(2) "That Mr. Charles T. McGinley, Jr., of CFNC, for his solicitude toward this Board after the 1968 CFNC Summer Chess Championship Tournament, be given a vote of thanks." (Morrison)

(3) "That the Refreshment Supervisor be ordered to include among the items for sale soft drinks, including at least an equal amount of the non-diet variety, for a trial period of one month, the funds accruing from the soft drinks to be accounted separately; that the Board shall then determine whether to continue the sales of soft drinks; and that candy not be sold." (Morrison, amended by Lee, with objection)

(4) "That all prizes for tournaments held by this club be given to the recipients within one month after the prize has been won." (Morrison)

(5) Set up an "Invitational Class Tournament," details to be forthcoming. (Lee)

An adjourned regular meeting of the Board was held on 23 July. Actions taken:

(1) To change somewhat the format of the clubs "Third Annual Bay Area Amateur Open Chess Tournament," details to be forthcoming. (Ng)

(2) Decided to field two teams for the CCCA League and two teams for the CFNC League. Team Captains: Jack Dennis, Theodore Anderson-Richard Lee (co-captains) for the CCCA League; Raymond Ng, Theodore Anderson-Richard Lee (co-captains) for the CFNC League. (Meyers)

(3) "That all players on an Oakland Chess Club team be members of the Oakland Chess Club before playing on that team." (Morrison)

*****MESSAGE FROM OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT*****

EDITORS' NOTE: We have been asked by the Oakland Police Department to include the following message in this newspaper.]

"Residential burglary in the City of Oakland is increasing at an alarming rate. Although no home is completely burglar-proof, there are some simple, common-sense precautions by which the homeowner can reduce the possibility of burglary: Install good locks on doors and windows, close and lock garage doors; notify the police of your absence when you are away; cancel all daily deliveries (mail, papers, milk, etc.); leave a lamp or two connected to an automatic timer

that will turn the lamps on for a few hours in the early morning hours. The purpose is to give the appearance that the resident is at home.
