

COSMO SUNDAY TOURNAMENT

On Sunday afternoon, July 12, the Cosmo Chess Club will hold its annual one-day Swiss Open Tournament at Cosmo quarters at 2180 W Adams Blvd. (RE-35358). Herman Steiner, internationally known chess master, will serve as tournament judge again this year. Registration will commence at 12:30 p.m., and drawings for the first round will be held at 1:00. Play in each round will last 45 minutes, after which all unfinished games will be adjudicated. Entry fee is \$1.00, and 90% of the proceeds will be returned in cash prizes to winners.

This annual tournament is Cosmo's openhouse to all the chess players of the county, and a merry time is traditionally had by all who participate.
