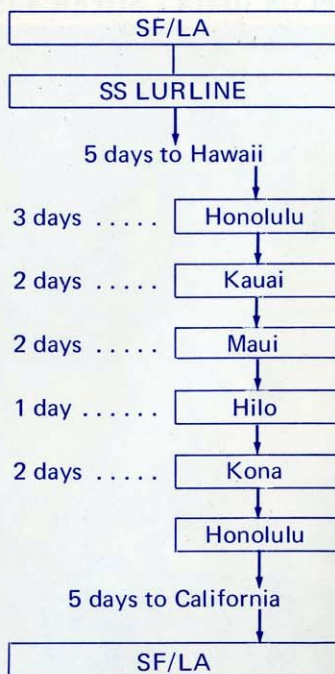
CHESS CRUISE AND PLAY THE S.S. LURLINE OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP
