

Bent Larsen of Denmark, who recently beat the World Champion Chess Player, Tigran Petrosian of Russia, in two tournaments, challenges another Dane, Victor Borge, backstage at the Greek Theatre. Ten top players from eight different countries competed in the recent tournament. The day following the tournament, Larsen played an exhibition match, challenging fifty-five players at once. At twenty-one years of age, Larsen was named International Grand Master, one of the youngest in history. In the challenge with Petrosian, only twenty-five moves were made. The tournament was played at the Miramar Hotel in Santa Monica.
