Helen Bennett also received a trophy for being the highest ranking woman in the tournament and the title of Monterey County Women's Chess Champion.

1966 Monterey County Junior Championship

Nicky Bogatirev became the First Monterey County Junior Champion. Michael Barthelow was runner-up. Both players received a trophy. The seven junior players competed in a 12 round double Round-Robin tournament. The final standings were as follows.

The Monterey County Championship was not a financial success. We took in \$131.00 but paid out \$153.00 - a net loss of \$22.00. This means that with just 4 more players in the tournament we could have broken even! However it was worth it just from the standpoint of what most of our club members gained in experience: playing in a U.S.C.F. rated tournament, being held to a "touch-move" rule, and using chess clocks. We did get fairly good publicity coverage from KIDD radio and the Monterey Peninsula Herald. We gained 3 new Monterey Peninsula Chess Club members and 12 more players became members of the United States Chess Federation. And now we have an idea of what the problems facing us in the MONTEREY INTERNATIONAL OPEN will be!!
