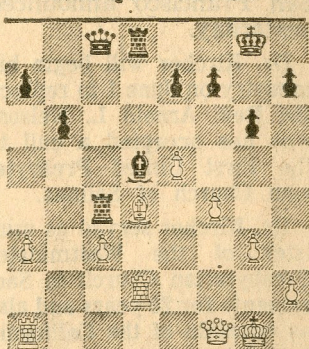


# Chess

Koltanowski (USA)

Move No. 30



White: Koltanowski's  
29th move was Q-KB1

If you were Koltanowski

next move?

### RULES:

Send a postcard with the move YOU would make to CHESS, care of this newspaper. Your card must bear the number of the move and must be post-marked before noon tomorrow. Your moves will be awarded four, three, two or one point by Koltanowski and at the end of the game prizes will be awarded to the readers who score the highest. Awarding of points for reader participation in this chess match will be at Koltanowski's discretion. His decision is final.

NOTES ON MOVE NO. 29: "Too bad that 29. BxP is not playable," says Koltanowski. "There would follow: 29. RxB; 30. RxB, RxR; 31. QxR, QxP; 32. R-R2 (best), R-N8ch; 33. K-N2, R-N7ch; 34. RxR." The position now shows White slowly developing the King's side for an eventual push of the King's side pawns, Black countering with an attack on the weak Queen's side pawns of White."

This, the 30th move, ends reader participation in the Koltanowski-Keres match. Names of the prize winners will be published as soon as the cards from Move 30 are tabulated, probably next Saturday, June 1.

Although at this point Keres holds the advantage, his edge is not enough to justify Koltanowski's conceding. Therefore, the game will continue and, once a week until its conclusion, The Chronicle will report on the progress of this match between the giants.

All participants will receive four points for Move No. 29.
