1966 NORTHERN CALIFORNIA CLASS CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT

You may not be able to beat Bobbie Fischer, but you can become the Class A, Class B, or Class C Chess Champion of Northern California for 1966 by entering this tournament and winning your division.

TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR: George Koltanowski (International Chess Master). The decision of the Tournament Director will be final in all matters.

SPONSORED BY: Lockheed Employees Recreation Association (LERA) Chess Club.

PLACE: Main auditorium of the Lockheed Employee's Recreation Association (LERA) located at the north end of Matilda Avenue (opposite Sunnyvale) seven blocks north of Bayshore freeway. Take the North Matilda off-ramp.

<u>DATE:</u> Weekend of September 17 and 18. There will be two rounds on Saturday and three rounds on Sunday. The first round starts promptly at 12:00 noon on Saturday.

TYPE OF TOURNAMENT: Five Round Swiss with three separate divisions: Class A, B, and C. There will not be an Unrated division; all unrated players will be given a provisional rating during registration.

PRIZES: Each division will have its own set of prizes as follows:

Cash Prizes: \$75 for highest score, \$40 for second highest score

Trophies: 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th place trophies; Solkoff, Median, and

Sonnenberg tie breaks in that order.

RATINGS: The IRS (Instantaneous Rating System) will be compulsory. Each player will know his handicap before each game and his new rating after each game. The CFNC Rating Administrator will verify all ratings.

REGISTRATION: From 10:00 AM to 12:00 noon at the LERA main auditorium. For better pairings we recommend that you register early, using the entry blank provided below.

ENTRY FEE: \$7.00

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all players who are (or will become) members of the Chess Firends of Northern California organization which is affiliated with the United States Chess Federation. Membership in CFNC is \$3.00 per year and includes eligibility in all CFNC events, a one year subscription to the CFNC magazine "Chess In Action", and an IRS rating.

EQUIPMENT: Bring your chess set and chess clock (clocks are not compulsary in C).

CONCORD OF THE EAST BAY LEAGUE STANDS AS THE CHAMPION TEAM AFTER A HARD FOUGHT PLAYOFF. PALO ALTO OF THE PENINSULA LEAGUE PLACED SECOND FOLLOWED BY SAN QUENTIN OF THE EL CAMINO REAL LEAGUE. CONCORD AND PALO ALTO DREW IN THE FIRST ROUND, PALO ALTO DEFEATED SAN QUENTIN IN THE SECOND ROUND AND CONCORD DEFEATED SAN QUENTIN IN THE THIRD ROUND. CONCORD DEFEATED PALO ALTO 3.5 TO 2.5 IN THE FOURTH AND FINAL ROUND FOR THE CHAMPIONSHIP.

NEW C.F.N.C. RATING SYSTEM

The rating list present in this issue of "Chess In Action" is current through the recent Oakland Tournaments (Oakland Open and Oakland Club Championship), the Lera "A" Tournament, and the Sonoma Festival. All of these events have been rated using the IRS (Instantaneous Rating System) procedure. The two main features of the IRS are:

- 1. The use of U.S.C.F. (United States Chess Federation) rating point system wherein 16 points (Instead of 40 points) are given for a win and 4% (instead of 20%) of the difference in rating represents the handicap.
 - 2. The ratings are calculated during the game so that all ratings are kept current.

Under the IRS, the two players involved in each game calculate their change in rating as a result of the outcome of their game. Each player will utilize a preprinted calculation sheet for each game to simplify the calculation procedure. Tournament Directors: When planning for a C.F.M.C. Tournament, contact the C.F.M.C. Rating Administrator

for the necessary rating forms.

The Rating Administrator checks all calculations and authorizes publication of the annual rating list and its supplements. It is planned that a supplement will be issued after each C.F.N.C. Tournament as part of the Tournament results (this was done in the case of the recent Oakland Open Tournament).

The decision to change to the U.S.C.F. rating point system and the I.R.S. procedure was reached at a meeting held in San Francisco on July the 3rd, 1966. Also, at this meeting Chuck McGinley requested that Jim Hurt take over the duties of C.F.N.C. Rating Administrator. George Koltanowski, Dave Betanco, Jim Hurt, Chuck McGinley, Mrs. C. McGinley, and Dick Phillips were present.
