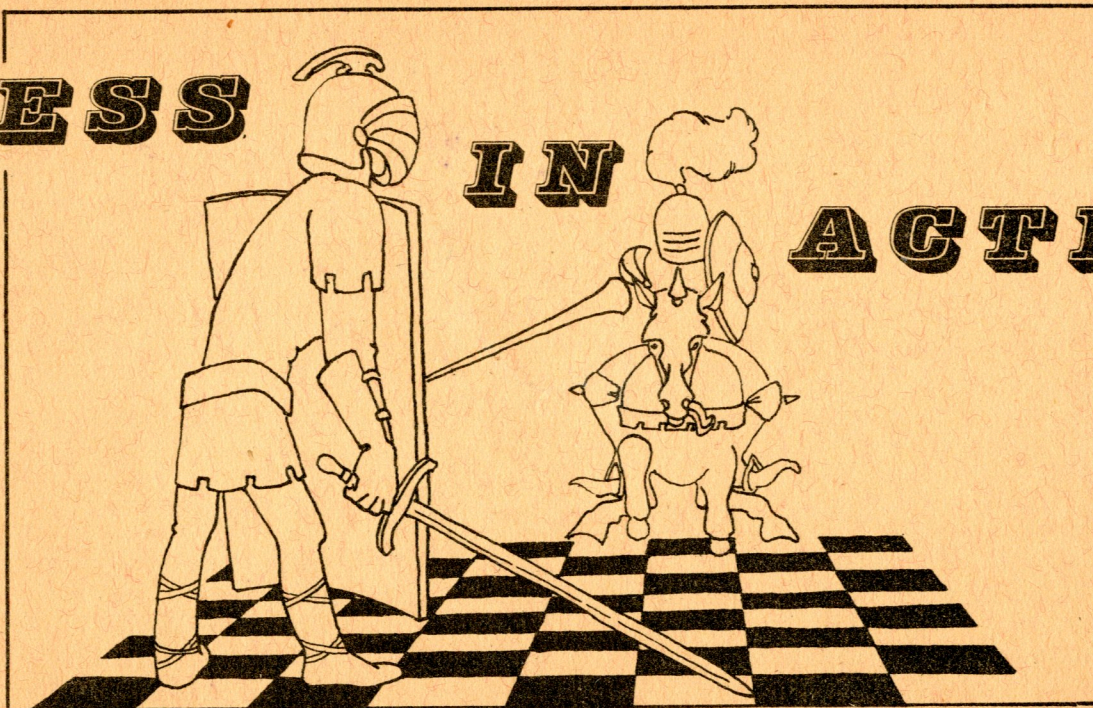

1966 PENINSULA OPEN CHESS CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT

TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR: George Koltanowski (International Chess Master). The decision of the Tournament Director will be final in all matters.

SPONSORED BY: Lockheed Employees Recreation Association (LERA) Chess Club.

PLACE: Main auditorium of the Lockheed Employee's Recreation Assoc. (LERA) located at the north end of Matilda Ave. (opposite Sunnyvale) seven blocks north of Bayshore freeway. Take the North Matilda off-ramp.

DATE: Weekend of March 26-27. There will be two rounds on Saturday and three rounds on Sunday. The first round starts promptly at 12 noon Sat.

TYPE*OF TOURNAMENT: Five Round Swiss with three separate divisions: EXPERT/A B and C/unrated. Each division will have its own set of prizes and will ensure that you compete with players of your own approximate strength. A MASTER division will be added if sufficient Master players register.

QUALIFIERS: The two top-scoring players of this tournament will qualify for the annual CFNC Expert (Money) Tournament, which in turn determines the two CFNC candidates to the California State Championship Tournament.

PRIZES: A number of prizes will be awarded in each division. These prizes will include chess clocks, chess sets, chess books. Also "surprise" prizes.

REGISTRATION: From 10 AM to 12 noon at the LERA main auditorium. For better pairings we recommend that you register early, using entry blank below.

ENTRY:FEE: \$4.00

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all players who are (or will become) members of Chess Friends of Northern California organization which is affiliated with the United States Chess Federation. Membership in CFNC is \$3.00 per year and includes eligibility in all CFNC events, a one year subscription to the CFNC magazine "CHESS IN ACTION" and an established rating.

EQUIPMENT: Please bring your own chess set and clock (clocks not compulsory).

RATINGS: Each player will obtain an established rating after the tournament.

CFNC rating changes are computed on the basic principle of forty points for a win or loss plus or minus twenty percent of the difference in ratings. For draws only the 20% applies. Thus a player with a rating of 150 pts. more than his opponent would gain 10 pts. for a win, lose 30 pts. for a draw and 70 pts. for a loss. His opponents rating would change accordingly.
