T H E G R A N D A F F A I R

Few of us have ever seen anything like it in So. California! If you missed it, you should never forgive yourself. Imagine - over 200 chessplayers from all clubs in the area, in one gathering on one afternoon to start the So. Calif. Chess League's great TEAM MATCHES! Sure made your heart glow. Players who previously have only heard of one another, in word or print, meeting for the first time, chatting, playing chess. Thirty-two teams participating, all at the newly acquired and decorated ATLAS CHESS CLUB.

Praise is indeed due to the League organizers, and sponsor Benton JAMES of the ATLAS Club, for putting on this tremendous show. With pre-numbered tables, all teams found their playing spots quickly, with the aid of name-cards and allocation-cards. Each player had his name "stuck" on himself for easy identification. Schedules, display material of all sorts, plus handsome cabinets with equipment greeted new arrivals right at the door; and all were required to guest-register. A top catering service was on hand to provide food and refreshments. And to top it all, an exciting match to be played, followed by Dr A. SAIDY's simultaneous exhibition coupled with lecture. What more could a chessplayer want?

The match results are a fine indication of the close contests to come. Out of the 16 matches, only five showed a one-sided result, four 5 - 1 scores and one clean sweep of 6 - 0. And some of these teams did not continue along their golden trail in the second round during the week. Full results will be found on the following pages, along with complete standings after Round Two for Divisions A and D; B and C had a bye-week so we can only show their first round standings.
