### LOOKING THROUGH THE PAWNOSCOPE

Some thoughts, observations, maybe even predictions....on the Grand Team Matches.....by DIAGONAL JIM.

#### DIWISION A

Well, looking deep down into things as we approach the halfway mark, it seems things have formulated somewhat and the defending champion STEINER team may do it again this year .... It took the team four rounds to reach first place, having to buck whirlwind starter PASADENA. but after the showdown necounter last week the champions are on their way. STEINER won three of their matches 41/2-11/2, and lead the fourth 31/2-1/2 with two adjourned games - a good showing, for sure.

PASADENA, always a bridesmaid never a bride, may surprise yet. They have tough opposition ahead, including Long Beach and the S.M. FALCONS, but getting by the formidable CITY TERRACE team with a resounding victory gave them quite a boost. CITY TE RACE has been erratic - if they straighten out, they'll be in the thick of things. The FALCONS and LONG BEACH are of course big guns in the division, but

so far haven't fired many shots - a sort of ambush?

NAA VALLEY may be the division "upsetters" - this team has been getting better each year. The remaining four teams - WHITTIER, STUDENT, the HORNETS and MONTEREY PARK will be battling for the lower positions, but a couple of good matches can throw any one of them into top-half contention. DIVISION B

RIVERSIDE will be tough to beat in this one, real tough. SEGUNDO and CITY TERRACE are closest in the lost games column, the main criterion here, but they haven't yet shown the consistency required to take the crown. WEST COVINA's chances we were about to discount, but after their fine win against MONTEREY PARK we'd better take a second look. The NAA VALLEY team collected almost as many points as the leaders, but they have a most unenviable schedule ahead.

From PASADENA we expected greater things - but something went amiss. WHITTIER and MONTEREY PARK really need the magic wand to le-
