DUST BITING TIME

Well, EL SEGUNDO did it again. It retained its reputation as the upsettingest of all the big ones ..... and is now fondly referred to as "the graveyard of the masters", "the nemesis of the experts" ..... and even "El Fecundo".

Highest-rated Tibor WEINBERGER drew right off the bat with Kenneth SMITH, while prodigal Steve SHOLOMSON dropped ½ point to 12-yr. old Larry CHRISTIANSEN. Ex-Calif. Champion Charles HENIN lasted four rounds before losing to high-flyer Aki KANAMORI; while So. Cal. Open winner K. KAHYAI and top expert G. SAIDI did badly enough to withdraw halfway through.

Our congratulations to KANAMORI who copped another triumph on the heels of his West Coast performance, piling up more calpoints in the process. HENIN and WEINBERGER were joined by Kim COMMONS at the 5-1 level to share second and third, COMMONS taking top Expert. The Class A prize was shared by K. HENSE, Ross STOUTENBOROUGH and Mexico's Enrique VILLASENOR. The latter went into the last round with 4½-½ and a win over Kim would have shot him into a tie for first - one of the best performances by this distinguished visitor. D. BERRY and P. YASUTAKE shared the B prize, Hampton JAMES took C, and a newcomer from Johannesburg, South Africa, Janos PLESKO, beat R. LALAZARIAN out for the unrated prize.

Of the 79 entries, 14 were masters and experts, most of them crying up a river. As usual, the organization was excellent, the hosts eminent, the conditions great. Aki KANAMORI picked up 15 calpoints, HENIN, WEINBERGER, and COMMONS 10 each, and the group of 4½ pointers 8 each. In our next issue, we will publish a table of calpoint holders. Our thanks to Hank SHIPIN, Georgina HOIM and her charming helpers. The tourney was directed by your editor.
