

Jr. Chess Tourney in 3-Way Tie

Defending champion Bobby Fischer, 14, of New York, was in a three-way tie for the lead yesterday after three rounds of the United States Junior Chess Championship here.

The tournament is being played in the auditorium of the Spreckels-Russell dairy at 1717 Mission street, and is open to the public. Sessions are from 9 a. m. to 1 p. m. and from 2 p. m. to 6 p. m.

Tied with Fischer, all with perfect scores of three wins, are Stephen Sholomson of Los Angeles and William Haines of Vallejo.

Gilbert Ramirez of San Francisco, the State junior champion, has 2½ points. There are 33 contestants from eight different States in the tournament.
