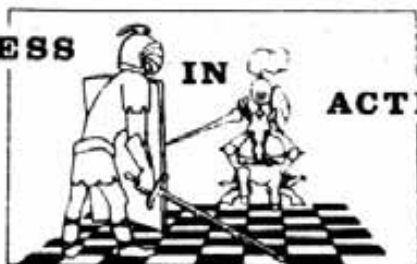


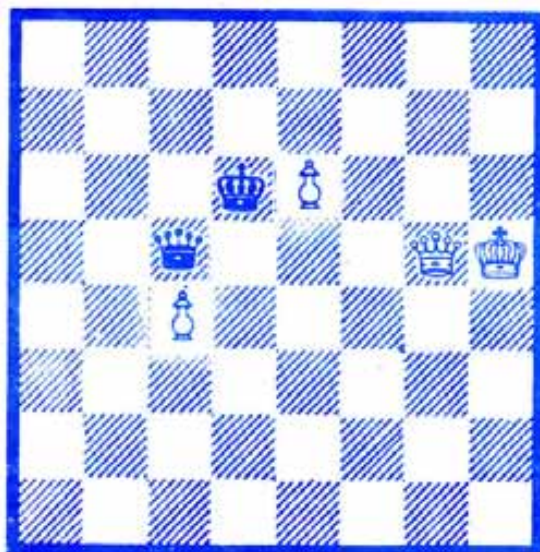

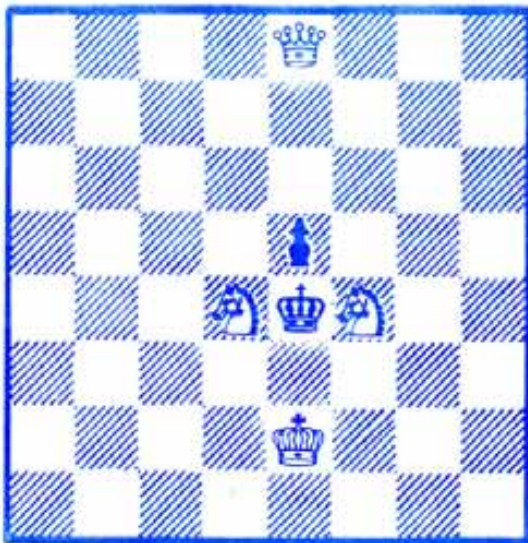

No. 25 White to take back his last move and mate in one.

Prizes will be awarded for the first set of correct solutions sent by a B-player and by a C-player to P.O. Box 451, Sunnyvale, Calif., 94088. Honorable mention will be made in the next Chess In Action for each player sending in correct solutions.

Our problems for this issue consist of a take-back mate-in-one; two straight-forward mate in twos; and a special-requirement mate-in-three. Problem No. 25 requires that you take back White's last move and replace it with a move that mates the Black King. Problem No. 26 is an easy symmetrical problem. Problem No. 27 is a not-so-easy mate-in-two with three main variations; very pretty. Problem No. 28 requires that you move each of your men just once and that you do not move the same man twice; it seems more difficult than it is.

Malek for winning the CFNC "A" division, to Amos Knack for winning the CFNC "B" division, and to Roger Bonilla for winning the CFNC "C" division. Results of the 1970 Sunnyvale Junior Open are presented on page 6. Congratulations are extended to Rodger Dusatko for winning the 14 and 15 year division, to Geoffrey Fong for winning the 11, 12, and 13 year division, and to Carolyn Withgitt for winning the 10 year and under division.

UPCOMING TOURNAMENTS The 7th Annual Oakland Summer Chess Tournament will be held at the CACA Oakland Lodge, 303 Eighth Street, Oakland, on the weekend of August 15 and 16. There will be a "E/A", "B", and "C" division. See page 20 for further details. The 2nd Annual Chabot Open will be held at Chabot College, Hayward, on the weekend of August 29-30. See page 21 for further details. The 5th Annual Sunnyvale Open will be held at LERA, Sunnyvale, on the weekend of September 26-27, 1970. There will be a USCF Open, a CFNC "B", and a CFNC "C" division. See page 22 for further details. The 1970 Santa Clara Junior Open will also be held that same weekend at LERA. See page 23 for further details. The Redwood City Open will be held at the Redwood City Activity Building, 1400 Roosevelt Ave, Redwood City, on the weekend of October 17-18, 1970. There will be a USCF Open, a CFNC "B", and a CFNC "C" division. The details will be printed in the next issue.

LEAGUE RESULTS Results of the 1970 West Bay League and the 1970 Peninsula League are presented on pages 10-18. Congratulations are extended to Redwood City for winning the West Bay League, and to LERA-C for winning the Peninsula League. The East Bay League is essentially complete and congratulations are extended to the Oakland Knights for winning this league.

RATINGS We continue the CFNC policy of using the IRS (Instantaneous Rating System) for tournament play whereby each player knows his rating before each game, knows his handicap rating once his opponent is selected, and knows his new rating as soon as his game is finished. League play ratings (presented in this issue) have been calculated using as start ratings the current ratings of all players as of July 1, 1970. To make room for the League Play Results, the Rating List has been left out of this issue of "Chess In Action." A method for determining (locating) your current CFNC rating is presented on page 10.

BOARD ACTION We need a CFNC Regional Director (or two) from the West Bay area. This is a request to the Daly City Chess Club and the Redwood City Chess Club to elect a CFNC Regional Director (one from each club) so we can get some "Board Action" going.

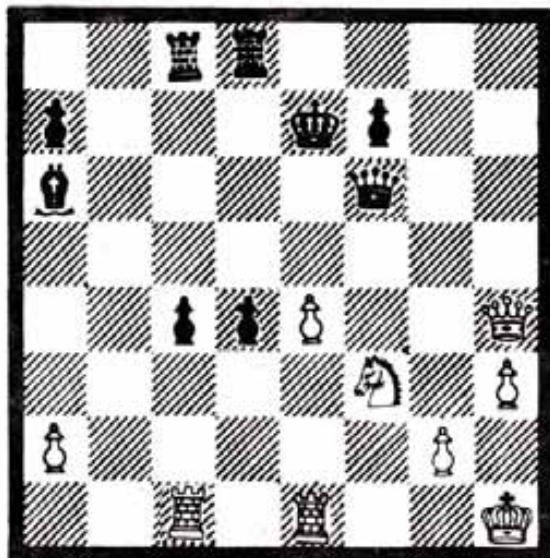

FIFTH ANNUAL 1970 PENINSULA OPEN CHESS CHAMPIONSHIP

The Fifth Annual 1970 Peninsula Open Chess Championship Tournament was held at LERA in Sunnyvale on the weekend of May 29-31, 1970. Mike Goodall of Berkeley acted as tournament director, doing his usual excellent job. As the estimated number of players was exceeded (94 instead of 90), cash prizes were increased to a total of \$525.00. In general, the players were pleased with this three-day tournament and its relaxed two-games-a-day schedule. Results are presented in the following paragraphs.

USCF Open Division. Congratulations are extended to Julio Kaplan of Berkeley for placing first overall (\$125.00) and to Erik Osburn of San Jose for placing second overall (\$65.00). 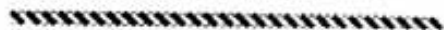

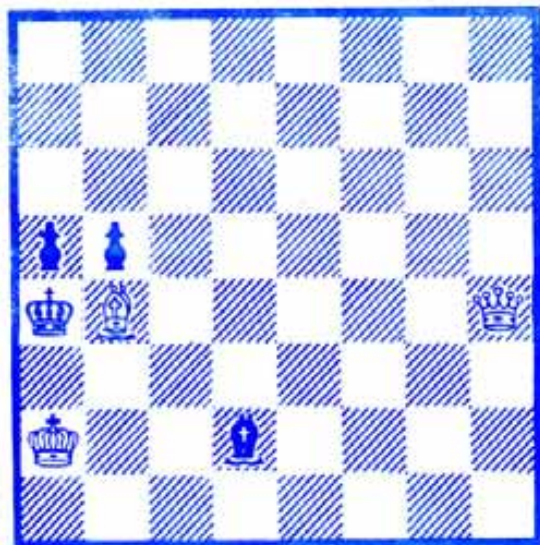

Problem No. 21 - White takes back his last move (which was PxB, promoting the pawn to a knight) and plays P-B8(N) checkmate.

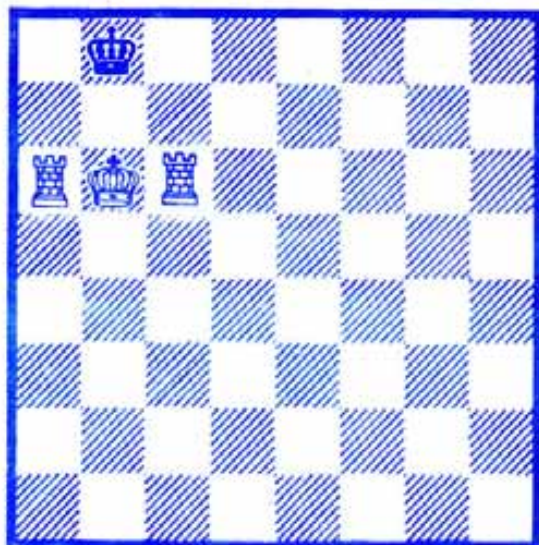
Problem No. 22 - 1 B-B8 KxB 2 Q-K8 mate.
