Place and dates: Intellectual Games Institute, 2288 Fulton & Bancroft Way, Berkeley 4, California. Saturday and Sunday, February 17th & 18th, 1962.

Who can play: Open to all interested players. Joining U.S.C.F. (\$5.00) is required only for those desiring national recognition.

Prizes: 75% of all entry fees will be returned as prizes! Expected entry to provide over \$200.00 in awards. Guaranteed minimum: \$100.00, trophies and four book prizes in each division, A, B and C.

Type of tournament: 5 round "Swiss". Director, Ronald Scott Thacker.
