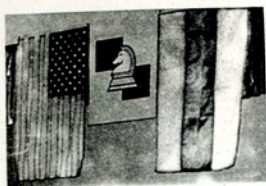

The idea of holding an international match between the chess nationals of the United States of America and Armenia was born in 1993, during the World Championship held in Lucern. Here the chess representatives of the USA won the right to be called team N 1 in the world, while the Armenian Grandmastess succeeded in being included in the first four of the strongest. Before that the Armenian National had won bronze in the latest World Olympiad held in Manila.

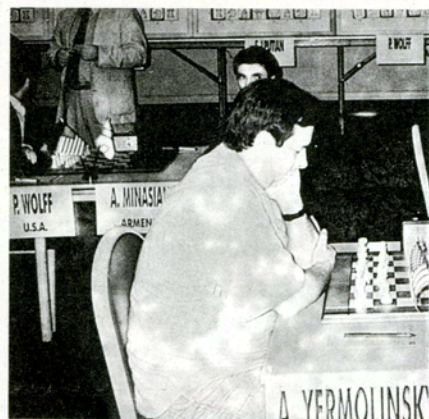
And so, invited by the US Chess Federation, the Armenian Chess National arrived in California. The international match was held in the satellite - town of Glendale, Los Angeles, on May 24-26, 1994. (The) "Stephen's Hall" in Los Angeles was lucky to witness the international match of the two strongest chess teams.

The choice of the match place was not accidental. Los Angeles is one of the cities most densely populated by Armenians. Therefore the interest caused by the match was enormous both for Americans and Armenians.

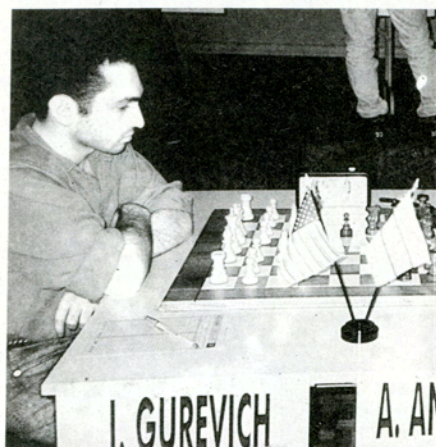

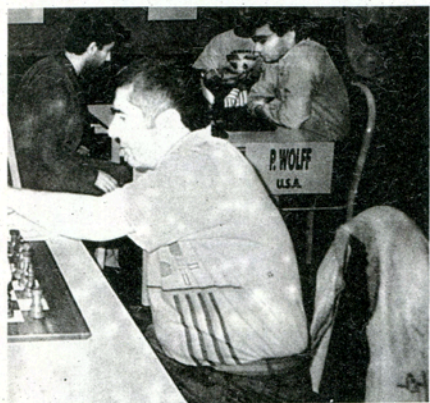

THE OPENING CEREMONY OF THE MATCH

The opening ceremony has begun an hour before the start of the US-Armenia Match in "Stephen's Hall" which houses about 400 spectators. The evening was conducted by Oshin Keshishian, a well-known public figure in the Armenian community in California. After the performance of the national anthems of the USA and the Republic of Armenia the audience was addressed by the Reverend Vache Hovsepian. Grandmaster Patrick Wolff spoke on behalf of the US National. On behalf of the Armenian delegation a speech was delivered by Gaguik Oganessian, the General Secretary of the Armenian Chess Federation. Then the Chief Referee of the Match, Rendy Hough (an international-class referee) introduced the order of the competition. The first two rounds were given 6 hours each (each competitor was to accomplish 40 moves within 2 hours and then the game was to be finished within 1 hour). The last two games were speeded up (each competitor was given 30 minutes to accomplish the game). Lots were drawn and according to the result the Americans were to begin at odd chessboards with the white.

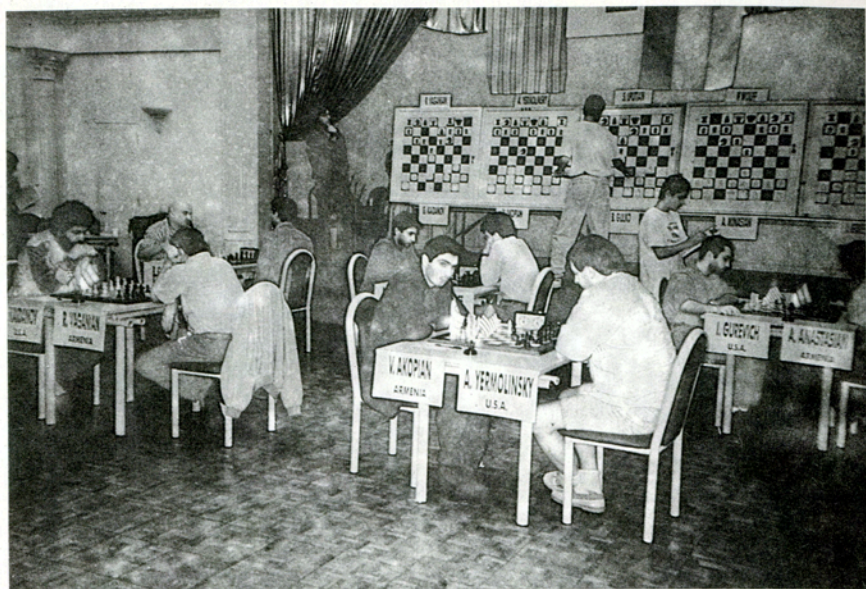

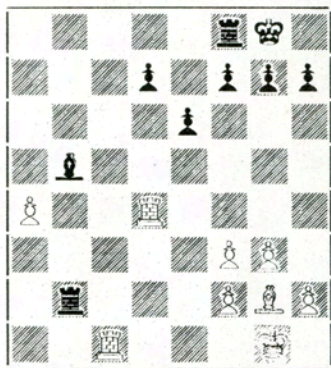
Round 1

In the first round the Armenian Grandmasters were obviously excited. It was particularly patent at chessboard 4. While there was a position of a draw, Minasian touched the rook. It was only at the last moment that he noticed his glaring mistake which was going to result in a mate. So he had to surrender. Lputian, in his turn, was very passive during the first game.

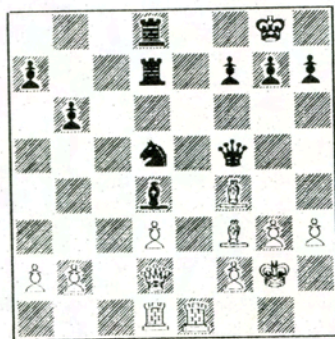
Round 2

The World Champions would have lost with a score of 0,5: 4,5 but Anastasian 'lent them a helping hand' failing in a favourable position.

The closing ceremony of the USA - Armenia match, held in the "Stephen's Hall", was cordial and touching though brief. 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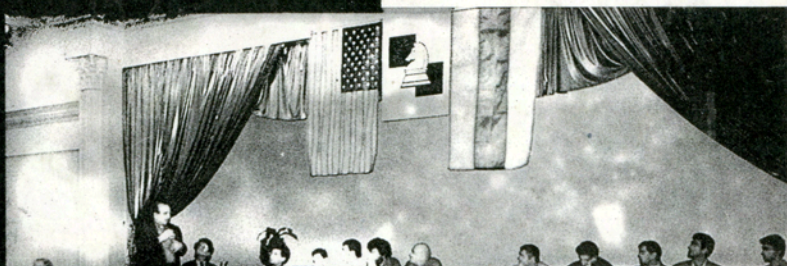
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
