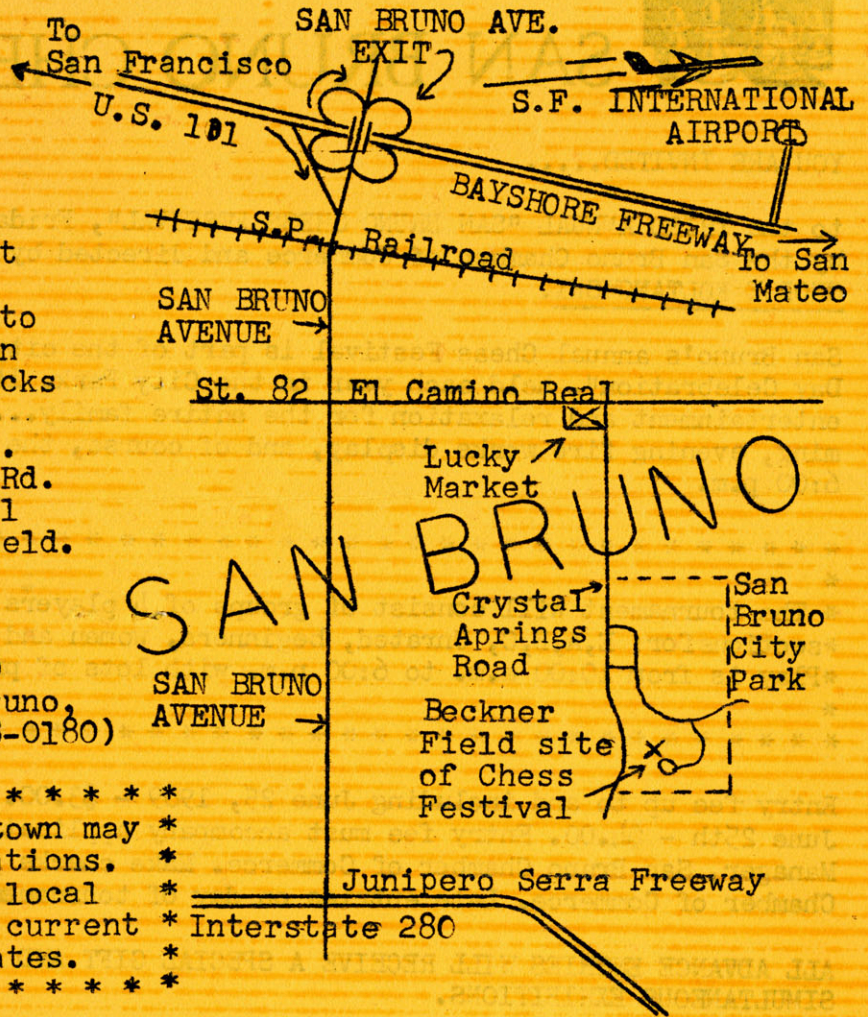


DIRECTIONS TO THE
