Dear Mr. Bisno:

I understand that you have been in telephonic contact with Mr. Kasper and are being kept steadily informed of developments in regard to the Reshevsky-Fischer match.

Most of the details now seem to be established and agreed upon with, of course, our continued expectation of getting all or a major part of the additional \$2,000. through your efforts on the West Coast. I'd like to know whether any individual or committee will be in charge of the West Coast games so that in the memorandum that I am preparing for the press, I can give all of that information. We here haven't yet determined on a place but as soon as we do, we can get out that memorandum which will give the basic information as to the event itself, the personalities involved, the referees, place, schedule, etc. From the letter received this morning from Miss Grumette, I gather that she will be handling the publicity on the West Coast. Subject to the information that she supplies me, I will get up a memorandum which we will use as a basic document to which we will add new and day-by-day developments. Of course, we will have to know the answers to such questions as the individual or group that will be in charge in L.A., the referee, place, and any other worthwhile human interest details.

Do please get word to me directly or through Miss Grumette and Mr. Kashdan with whom I am also corresponding on this.
