Intermediate Chess

Illustrated lectures combined with supervised play. Improving strategy, openings, defense, endings, and general chess knowledge. To qualify for the course, enrollees should have some knowledge and experience in chess. Enrollment is limited. Please bring chess set.

Advanced Chess

Illustrated lectures combined with supervised play. Opening and endgame knowledge, middle-game ideas, and the style of the grandmasters (including that of Bobby Fischer's challenger for the world title in 1975). Enrollees should have a high C chess rating or comparable playing experience. Please bring chess set.

Instructor: GEORGE KOLTANOWSKI holds the rank of International Chess Master as well as the official title of World's Blindfold Chess Champion. He has written a daily syndicated chess column for the San Francisco Chronicle since 1947. His programs "Koltanowski on Chess" and "Grandmaster Chess" have been featured on National Educational Television.
