

Reshevsky—Fine Match

Enthusiastic supporters of Samuel Reshevsky of Los Angeles and Dr. Reuben Fine of New York are trying to arrange a match between the two grandmasters to take place in New York sometime in June. It is hoped that a purse of \$5,000 can be raised to finance the encounter.

Although it would be contested entirely in the United States, the match would be of major international significance. Reshevsky, five times holder of the U. S. title, and Fine, winner of the recent New York International Tourney, are rated among the world's strongest players. They are on the list of those who will compete this summer in the Buenos Aires candidates' tournament. The winner of this latter event will meet World Champion Mikhail Botvinnik in match play sometime during 1950.
