U.S. Open Championship

ARTHUR "BISCUIT" BISQUIER WINS IT

OMAHA, NEB., Aug 2. Arthur "Biscuit" Bisquier of New York won the 60th U.S. Open Championship with a 10-2 record over twelve hard gruelling rounds; 2nd and 3rd respectfully were Raymond Weinstein of Brooklyn and Pal Benko of New York with like scores of $9\frac{1}{2}$ - $2\frac{1}{2}$. So, it was an all New York affair as far as the top prizes were concerned, despite the fact that California beat New York in the recent USCF "Operation M" drive for national membership.

Other scores were for 4th and 5th, Eliot Hearst, Arlington, Va., and Hans Berliner, Littleton, Colo with scores of 9-3. Scoring $8\frac{1}{2}$ - $3\frac{1}{2}$ were Gilbert Ramirez, San Francisco, Calif., James Sherwin, New York, Robin Ault, Cranford, N. J., Olaf Ulvestad, Seattle, Charles Henin, Chicago, Ill., and Robert Steinmeyer, St. Louis, Mo.

Robin Ault of Cranford, N. J. won the U.S. Junior Championship over Gilbert Ramirez of San Francisco, Calif., but Gil got some revenge (or satisfaction) by finishing slightly above Robin in the tournament for the giants of chess.

George Koltanowski, writer for the San Francisco CHRONICLE, directed the tourney and as is always expected of him, in the usual, smooth and authoritative manner.

SONOMA FESTIVAL

The Ninth Annual Valley of the Moon Chess Festival will again amaze all that attend at the Plaza in Sonoma, Calif. on Sunday, August 9, 1959. The merchants of this little town of California have taken the chess players and fans into their hearts. 4-player tournaments dominate the affair, with simultaneous exhibitions on the side.

ROUND 1: Went true to the form sheet. The only surprise came when unrated Leuderitz stopped Spencer Van Gelder.

ROUND 2: Finds Mike Ewell wondering if the tournament contains anyone but McLeod's as he drops his second game to this husband-wife team.

ROUND 3: Most of the top players hold each other to a stand-off while Farly, Hoffman, J. Ramirez and Johnson upset Hendricks, Hampton, Ben Wong and Reynolds respectively.

ROUND 4: Pits TD Henry Gross (3-0) against Robert Burger (3-0), the CALIFORNIA CHESS REPORTER'S games annotator. Burger proves too much for USCF & West Coast Master Gross to take the undisputed lead. Hoffman clips his second superior rated opponent in a row-- Roy Hoppe, this time. Dahl and Freeman draw (2nd for each) to remain undefeated, while yours truly gets his first mark in the win column by virtue of a draw with Ben Wong. Among the undefeated are Robert Burger, Eugene Krestini, Jules Kalisch, Peter Dahl and Russell Freeman.

ROUND 5: BACL President Henry Gross topples BACL Secty-Treasurer Russell Freeman from the ranks of the undefeated. (That's one way to keep your boss happy, Russ.) Don Sutherland clips Peter Dahl, while E. Krestini stops R. Burger to move into undisputed first place ($4\frac{1}{2}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$) with five players hot on his heels at 4-1. Nancy McLeod and McCollough lead the "B" class with 3-2 with Mike Ewell and Don Hoffman atop the "C's" with 2-3.

ROUND 6: With only one draw in this round, all games went according to the form sheet. Krestini ($5\frac{1}{2}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$) still leads with Henry

RATING THE BAY AREA IND. LEAGUE PLAYERS

All computations for the July quarterly rating list were based on published reports in the Pacific Coast CHESS HERALD from January to June, 1959, inclusive. Although 95 persons were active in the B.A.I.L. 1958-59 season, only the 38 players who competed in five or more matches could be rated with a reasonable degree of statistical accuracy.

In the absence of previous tournament or match performance for nearly all of the B.A.I.L. members, the initial ratings are based on percentages. Forfeit wins or losses were not counted. The following is a list of the eleven "most valuable" league players:

S.F. OPEN REPORT BY TULLIS (continued)

Gross and Robert Burger close behind with 5-1. Class A is still a rat-race with six players tied at 4-2. Jack Pinneo now leads the B class with 3½-2½ and Don Hoffman holds his lead in the C class 3-3. ROUND 7: Henry Gross, like Burger in Rd 5, finds Eugene Krestini too much, and the bookies are no longer taking bets on this tournament. The Prize List at this point are: 1st, Krestini (6½-½), 2nd, Burger (5½-½), 3rd, Gross (5-2), Class A, L. Allen (5-2) by tie breakers over King and Sutherland, Class B, Pinneo (4½-2½), a point and a half ahead of his peers; Class C, Don Hoffman (4-3), also 1½ ahead. ROUND 8: Peter Dahl and Russell Freeman stop Eugene Lien and Jules Kalich respectively to catch up in the A Class as Allen, King and Sutherland all lose. Hoffman stops Curtis Wilson to continue his run-away pace in the C Division. ROUND 9: Dahl falls to Allen, Freeman takes his turn trying to beat Krestini to put the Class A race back to Round 7. Gross but still lead their divisions.

This round was mixed in with the annual East-West match only have the East team upset the West 14-13. (Editor's note-- first time since it was ever started, so about time.)

ROUND 10: Krestini now has 9½-½, Burger 8½-1½, Gross 8-2, Ledgerwood 7-3; Class A Allen, King Freeman, Willson each with 6-4; Class B-- Nancy McLeod catches up to Jack Pinneo at 6-4, and Don Hoffman continues his breathtaking pace at 5½-5½.

ROUND 11: Krestini, Burger, Allen, stop Wilson, Freeman and Nancy McLeod as King and Pinneo draw. Larry Ledgerwood halts Henry Gross to move into third. The standings going into the final round: Eugene Krestini is the new San Francisco Champion; Robert Burger will be second. Larry Ledgerwood (8-3) third, and Henry Gross (8-3) fourth are just out of reach. Class A race has Leighton Allen (7-4) leading Henry King (6½-4½); Class B has Jack Pinneo (6-5) followed by Norman Nielsen (5½-5½) and McCullough (5½-5½); Class C is led by Don Hoffman (5½-5½) who is folbwd by J. Johnson (4½-6½).

ROUND 12: Ledgerwood and Gross win to split third place money; Leighton Allen stops Jules Kalisch to take the Class A trophy; Jack Pinneo stops Dan McLeod to take the B Cup; and Hoffman clips Johnson to win the Class C honors. ***JUST WAIT UNTIL NEXT YEAR.....

RATING COVERAGE THIS QUARTER

This rating list is up-to-date with the cross-table results of tournaments and matches as published in these periodicals: Pacific Coast CHESS HERALD to June 1959 inclusive (excepting the North-South Match and the Central California Chess League); the CALIFORNIA CHESS REPORTER to December 1958 inclusive; the IDAHO CHESS BULLETIN to April 1959 inclusive; and the WASHINGTON CHESS LETTER to April 1959 inclusive (plus the Wallace High School Tournament and the Portland High School chess matches in the May 1959 issue).

MINIMUM NUMBER OF GAMES

Although a rating card is prepared for every person who plays in any match or tournament, his rating often does not begin to stabilize until at least five games are reported. This also applies to rating changes between publishing a rating until five games accumulate. If your name is not listed, you may consider your rating as "officially" unchanged; that is, for the purpose of entering and being paired in tournaments.

MASTERS AND SENIOR MASTERS

The numerical evaluation of both masters and senior masters does not seem to serve a useful function. Effective with this list, only the names will be given with their classification. The numerical rating for masters and senior masters will, in the future, be made available to the individuals concerned at their request—, through the editor of CHESS HERALD, or from the Ratings Statistician direct.
